POLICY ISSUES

2009/EB.2/2 WFP School Feeding Policy

The Board approved the "WFP School Feeding Policy" (WFP/EB.2/2009/4-A) and requested:

- i) the Secretariat to keep the Board informed about the proposed revisions and the progress in implementation of the policy in the course of 2010; and
- ii) the Office of Evaluation to conduct a comprehensive evaluation of WFP school feeding, including early implementation of the new policy, to be presented to the First Regular Session in 2012.

2009/EB.2/3 WFP Policy on Capacity Development: An Update on Implementation

The Board took note of "WFP Policy on Capacity Development" (WFP/EB.2/2009/4-B). The Secretariat would keep the Board informed on the progress of implementing the capacity development policy, and would share with the Board the implementation plan referred to in paragraph 54.



2009/EB.2/4 WFP Gender Policy: Corporate Action Plan (2010–2011)

The Board took note of "WFP Gender Policy: Corporate Action Plan (2010–2011)" (WFP/EB.2/2009/4-C).

RESOURCE, FINANCIAL AND BUDGETARY MATTERS

2009/EB.2/5 WFP Biennial Management Plan (2010–2011)

Having considered WFP's Biennial Management Plan budget for 2010–2011, as submitted by the Executive Director in document WFP/EB.2/2009/5-A/1 + Corr.1 the Board:

- i) as allowed under Financial Regulation 2.1, **approved** an exemption from Financial Regulation 9.2 which requires that the proposed Management Plan be circulated to members of the Board not later than 60 days before the session;
- ii) **took note** of the projected operational requirements of US\$8.37 billion, excluding any provision for unforeseen emergencies and including direct support costs (DSC), as outlined in Section II;
- iii) **took note** that the Programme Support and Administrative (PSA) budget proposal assumed a funding level of 84 percent of the programme of work;
- iv) **approved** a PSA appropriation of US\$476 million for the following purposes:

Programme support: regional bureaux and country offices

Programme support: Headquarters US\$118.140 million

Management and administration US\$212.848 million

Total US\$476.002 million

- v) **approved** one-time supplementary PSA appropriations of up to US\$25.9 million funded from the PSA Equalization Account as outlined in Section III;
- vi) **approved** expenditures of up to US\$24.4 million funded from the General Fund for the United Nations Department of Safety and Security;
- vii) **approved** the carry forward of US\$14.5 million of the US\$22.5 million approved for allocation from the General Fund at EB.2/2008 for WFP field security upgrades;
- viii) **approved** an advance of US\$4.5 million from the General Fund for the private-sector partnerships and fundraising strategy;
 - ix) **approved** an indirect support cost (ISC) recovery rate of 7.0 percent for the 2010–2011 biennium; and
 - x) **authorized** the Executive Director to adjust the PSA component of the budget in accordance with any variation in the volume of operational requirements of more than 10 percent from levels outlined in Section II.

The Board welcomed the meeting on 4 November 2009 among the senior managers of FAO, IFAD and WFP, led by the three heads of agencies.

The Board took note of the revitalization of the Committee on World Food Security (CFS) and requested a strong, active participation of WFP in its work, including the Joint Secretariat and the Advisory Group, with a view to improving coordination and joint action for food security and nutrition. The Board further welcomed the unity demonstrated by the three heads of Rome-based agencies at the last session of the CFS, when they were seated together at the podium and took the floor during the opening ceremony.

The Board looked forward to witnessing the same level of unity during the coming World Summit on Food Security.

The Strategic Plan will highlight WFP strategic objectives and their implications for the proposed programme of work."
