

Introduction

1. The Immediate Response Account (IRA) was established in December 1991 by the Committee on Food Aid Policies and Programmes (CFA) with an original target level of US\$30 million. This level was later increased in 1995 to US\$35 million by the CFA, and to US\$70 million in 2004 at the Board's Second Regular Session. The IRA is a multilateral fund facility that enables WFP to provide immediate food aid including logistical and other non-food costs in an emergency situation. Since its inception, the IRA has repeatedly proved its value as one of the most effective relief response mechanisms.

- 2. In considering the document "Review of the Immediate Response Account (IRA)" (WFP/EB.3/2004/12-A), the Board requested the Secretariat to submit a formal annual information paper on the use of the IRA.
- 3. The purpose of this document is to provide information on the use of the IRA during 2005.
- 4. The Secretariat will continue to periodically update Board members on the use of the IRA through the publication *Estimated Food Needs and Shortfalls for WFP Operational Activities*, commonly referred to as the *Yellow Pages*, which is issued three times a year concurrently with each Board session.

Facts about the IRA

Allocations from the IRA fund are made as loans to eligible operations in anticipation of receiving donor contributions. If no such donations are received, as sometimes occurs in life-threatening situations, the loan is deemed to be a permanent, non-reimbursable grant from the IRA.

The IRA serves as both a replenishable and a revolving fund. "Revolving" means that funds allocated from the IRA to an operation may subsequently be reimbursed to the IRA account with donor contributions received for that operation. Contributions that are used to revolve the IRA are accounted for and reported under the operation to which the donor pledged them.

Donor contributions made directly to the IRA facility replenish the Fund.

In-kind contributions or contributions with donor conditions such as bag markings restrict the possibility of revolving the IRA.

USE OF THE IRA, 1 JANUARY – 31 DECEMBER 2005

5. The significance of the IRA as one of WFP's effective mechanisms in responding swiftly to emerging and rapidly increasing humanitarian needs was once again demonstrated in 2005. As a result of multiple crises throughout the year, IRA allocations reached a record high of US\$103.7 million, nearly double the 2003 level, giving WFP the flexibility to respond in a timely manner to 35 operations.



6. During 2005, in addition to addressing complex emergencies such as the earthquakes in Pakistan, hurricane Stan in Central America and the drought and locust devastation in Niger, IRA funds were used to provide urgently needed food to millions of people affected by the greater Darfur crisis, the Togolese refugee crisis that occurred in several West African countries, the drought and locust infestation in Mali and by hurricanes and floods which affected Cuba, Guyana and Pakistan. The fund was also used to assist with needs relating to the Indian Ocean Tsunami. The recent evaluation of the Niger operation highlighted the critical role of the IRA in supporting WFP's emergency response.

- 7. Through the prompt utilization of IRA funds, 22 relief operations including seven special operations (SOs) benefited from IRA allocations. Country Directors approved 13 immediate response emergency operations (EMOPs) for which funds were made available within 48 hours.
- 8. In line with the Board's endorsement of the scope and expanded use of the IRA, the effectiveness of this fund was also realized in the important role played in averting pipeline breaks during the year in the protracted relief and recovery operations for Kenya, Ivory Coast and Central America. IRA funds were also instrumental in WFP's emergency preparedness efforts. Needs assessments in Kyrgyzstan, Panama and the Sahel were funded through the IRA; food and non-food items were purchased and pre-positioned in West Africa in advance of a potential eruption of violence.



- 9. The US\$103.7 million of approved allocations in 2005 is a 19 percent increase over 2004. A large portion of funds advanced to address immediate needs in emergency situations was revolved back into the IRA once donors had contributed to the operations. The amount revolved into the account in 2005 totalled US\$63.4 million, a 15 percent increase over 2004. It is mainly thanks to this revolving of the IRA that WFP was able to continue to advance substantial amounts to other operations in need of funds.
- 10. In October 2004, the Board approved an increase in the IRA target level from US\$35 million to US\$70 million per year in recognition of the effectiveness of the IRA mechanism. However, donor contributions to the IRA decreased from US\$25.1 million in 2004 to US\$18.7 million in 2005, resulting in an average cash balance of under US\$30 million the lowest cash balance since 2002.



11. As a critical component of WFP's efforts to respond to four concurrent emergencies and to secure the replenishment of the IRA, WFP will concentrate its efforts to increase the cash balance to the target of US\$70 million through increased advocacy and faster and increased revolving of the account by country offices, and by encouraging donors to ease restrictions on bag markings. Advances to emergency operations often secure locally or regionally purchased commodities for immediate — often the first — distribution to beneficiaries.
