### **ANNEX V**

## Collaboration between UNICEF and WFP in the field of Basic Education in Burkina Faso

UNICEF and WFP Representatives in Burkina Faso signed a Letter of Agreement in 2003 which formed the basis of their collaboration in the basic education sector.

Currently, schools benefiting from UNICEF assistance also receive WFP food assistance. More than 60 percent of schools supported by WFP are targeted by UNICEF, whose assistance covers provision of drinking water, toilets and teaching materials.

This collaboration will continue and will be strengthened through the new cycle 2006–2010. Although it is not stated specifically, under the two new country programmes UNICEF and WFP will together programme activities in education, health and nutrition, with an emphasis on targeted implementation and joint monitoring and evaluation of the United Nations Girls' Education Initiative (UNGEI).

UNFPA, United Nations Volunteers (UNV), UNESCO, the World Bank and the United Nations Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat) will be involved in the basic education sector, in addition to UNICEF.
