Between 1 July and 31 December 1999, the Executive Director authorized 13 budgetary increases within her delegated authority for approved protracted relief and recovery operations. The food value of these increases amounts to US\$5.8 million and the total cost to WFP to US\$11.7 million. Detailed budgetary figures and reasons for each increase are given overleaf.
