### **2000/EB.2/1 Evaluation Reports**

**a) Joint WFP/UNHCR Evaluation of Protracted Relief Operation (PRO) Kenya 4961.04—Food Assistance to Somali and Sudanese Refugees (WFP/EB.2/2000/3/2)**

The Board considered the Joint WFP/UNHCR Evaluation Report on PRO Kenya 4961.04, together with the accompanying information note (WFP/EB.2/2000/INF/10) summarizing the report's recommendations and measures taken to implement them. It endorsed the Secretariat's plan to incorporate these recommendations in the design of the new protracted relief and recovery operation (PRRO). The Board requested the Secretariat to take also into account further comments made by representatives.

**b) Summary Terminal Evaluation Report on Emergency Operation (EMOP) China 6045.00—Emergency Food Aid to Flood-affected People in Anhui, Hubei, Hunan and Jiangxi Provinces of China (WFP/EB.2/2000/3/1)**

The Board considered the Summary Report of the Terminal Evaluation of EMOP China 6045.00. It recommended that the lessons emerging from this evaluation be integrated into future emergency operations elsewhere.



**c) Summary Evaluation Report on Kosovo Regional EMOP 6040.00—Food Assistance to Kosovar Internally Displaced Persons and Refugees in the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, Albania and the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia (WFP/EB.2/2000/3/5)**

The Board considered the Summary Evaluation Report on Kosovo Regional EMOP 6040.00, together with the accompanying information note (WFP/EB.2/2000/INF/8) summarizing the report's recommendations and measures taken to implement them. It took note of the lessons identified for application in future operations of this nature, taking into account considerations raised by representatives.

**d) Mid-term Evaluation of PRRO Cambodia 6038.00—Food Aid for Recovery and Rehabilitation in Cambodia (WFP/EB.2/2000/3/6)**

The Board considered the Mid-term Evaluation Report on PRRO Cambodia 6038.00, together with the accompanying information note (WFP/EB.2/2000/INF/9) summarizing the report's recommendations and measures taken to implement them. It endorsed the Secretariat's plan to reflect the recommendations in the design of the successor PRRO.

**e) Summary Report on the Evaluation of WFP's Project Portfolio in Peru (WFP/EB.2/2000/3/3)**

- **Peru 2341—Food Assistance to Women's Groups for the Development of Women's Micro-enterprises**
