- Mainly PRROs linked to food crises in 2008 and 2012
- But also included a number of development operations

Indicative collaboration framework

Providing technical assistance for developing national expertise in:

- 1. Food and Nutrition insecurity Analysis
- 2. National/Regional strategic/emergency reserves, food stocks
- 3. *Safety nets*
- 4. Stunting reduction, including food fortification
