

Update Operational Ethiopia



- 10.2 million in need of assistance
- Government, supported by WFP, is leading the response for 7.6 million
- Heavy rains have caused loss of lives and livelihoods and delays in delivery
- Nutrition support scaled up for 640,000
- USD426 million required for drought response
- USD23 million needed to meet needs of 600,000 refugees

Update **Operational** Sudan South



- Transitional Government has been formed
- ~ 5 million in need of assistance
- Needs spread beyond conflict affected states
- 33% increase in SAM admissions
- Scale up of assistance ongoing
- USD 106 million shortfall for food assistance operations



Movement through Eritrea corridor for first time in 10 years
33 trucks crossed the Eritrean-Sudan border with 1,100 MT

update Kenya refugee



Dadaab

- Government of Kenya has announced the closure of Dadaab
- The camp currently hosts 326,000 primarily Somali refugees
- UNHCR leading discussions with the Government

<u>Kakuma/Kaloboyei</u>

- New settlement promotes self reliance
- WFP providing CBTs and market support
