
WFP Emergency Response Classification System

 March 2006
First WFP Activation Protocol for Responding to Corporate Emergencies introducing a 3 level classification system. (Critical Incident Standard Operating Procedures issued in March 2010).

April 2012 • IASC System-Wide Response Classification System.

- October 2012 Informed by Lessons Learned from 2006 Protocol and reflecting IASC System-Wide Response Classification System.
 - Introduced an "Organisational Resilience" approach aligning Activation Protocol with revised crisis management and new Business Continuity Management Protocol.
 - Introduced criteria of scale, complexity, urgency, capacity and reputational risk.
- Planned revision.

- Central African Republic
- Philippines

- Increasing number of Level 2 or Level 3 responses.
- Longer duration of Level 3 responses.
- Current Situation:
 - > Three Level 3 (Syria, CAR and South Sudan).
 - Four Level 2 (Mali, Yemen, DRC and Somalia).
