GOAL: Capability to mount a more efficient and effective emergency response for up to 6 million beneficiaries (as per GRCM).

Objective 1 (Capacities)

➤ To strengthen WFP corporate response capacities to support emergency response for up to 6 million beneficiaries.

(food, funds, personnel, NFI, logistics services, information and knowledge).

Objective 2 (Abilities)

To strengthen the accountability and coherence of WFP's response management. (normative framework, protocols, SOPs, Delegations, systems, tools, etc.).

Objective 3 (External)

➤ To strengthen partnership with national response actors, the international humanitarian community and other humanitarian actors for a more effective response.

(CAPRO, Transformative Agenda, Humanitarian Common Services, Civ-Mil, etc.).

- CAPRO (National Readiness & Response Augmentation) as per 2014-17
 Strategic Plan and 2014 Management Plan.
- Operational Information Management (OIM) capacity-building.
- Sub-National Office enhancement project.
- Transformative Agenda implementation.
- Joint WFP-UNICEF project on "Strengthening Humanitarian Preparedness in High Risk Countries".



Post-PREP: Emergency Preparedness & Response (EPR) Strengthening

- Mainstreaming into 2015 Management Plan.
- Reflecting 15 years of EPR learning and knowledge, including 2014 strategic evaluation findings, into first EPR Policy (EB 2015).
- Continual EPR-related learning/knowledge management to guide timely investment in the maintenance and development of EPR capacities, abilities and partnerships.
