


Sub-national Prevalence of Chronic Undernutrition (WFP 2008)








2. FOOD PRICES STILL HIGHER THAN 2007





Food Prices progression from 2007to 2009 (National Databases SMIA-FAO, 2009)


3. UNEMPLOYMENT & DROP IN REMITTANCES




