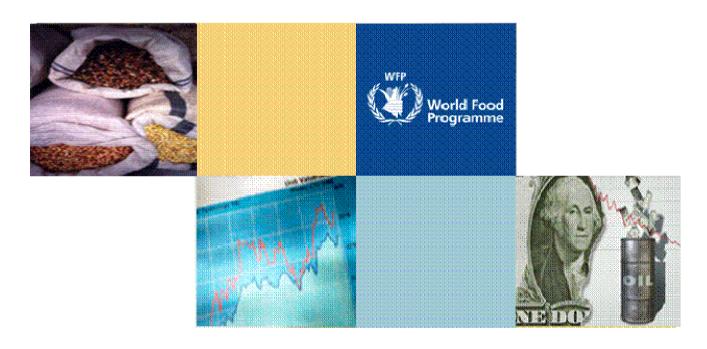

Background

- Management Plan 2008-2009 budget based on an expected price increase of 10%
- Since finalization of the operational budget in June 2007 commodity prices have increased radically
- Volatility and continued price rises for commodity markets, fuel (crude oil) and exchange rates







Background cont.

- Management Plan 2008-2009 (Oct 2007):
 - Food budget \$2.4 billion
 - Total operational requirements \$5.4 billion (excl. ISC)
- Management Plan Update (Feb 2008):
 - Food budget \$3.075 billion
 - Total operational requirements \$6.376 billion (excl. ISC)
- February estimates:
 - 2008 Impact \$500 million (Press Releases)

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WFP Cereal Index

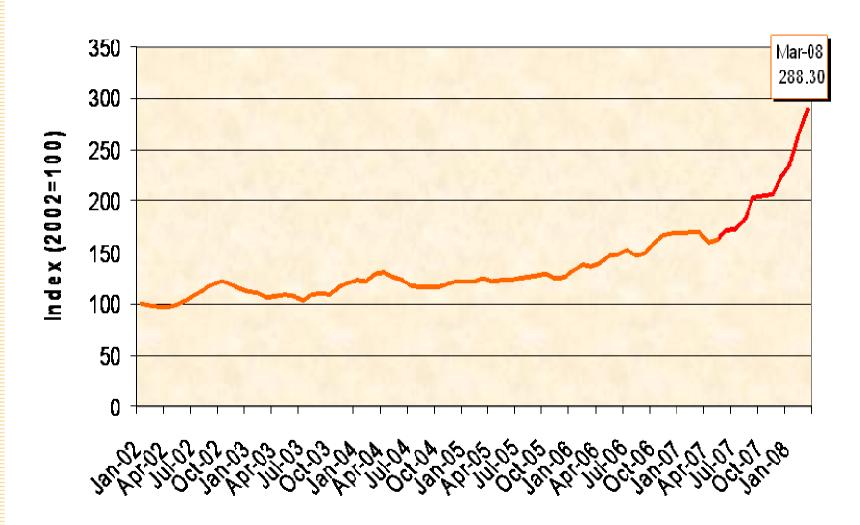
- Composed of four cereals: Maize,

- These four cereals represent 41% of the value of the WFP food basket for 2007
- Weight of each commodity in the WFP Cereal Index based on its value in the WFP food basket in 2007
- Prices from FAO International Commodity Prices

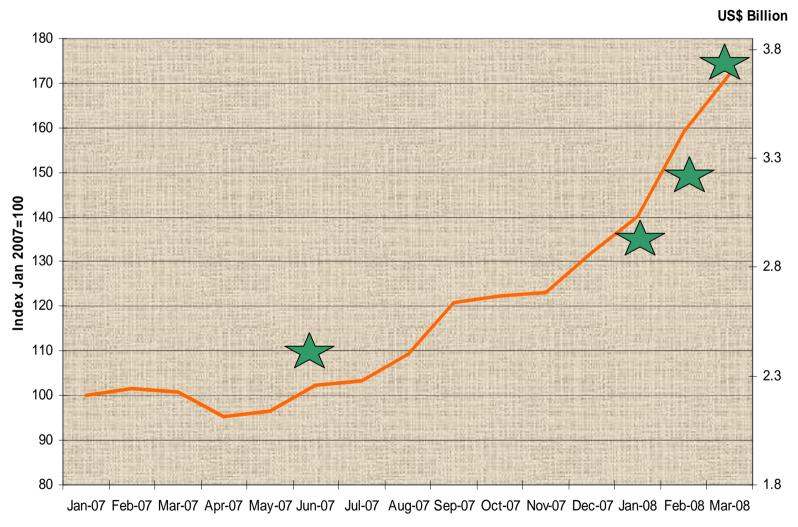

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Associated Costs

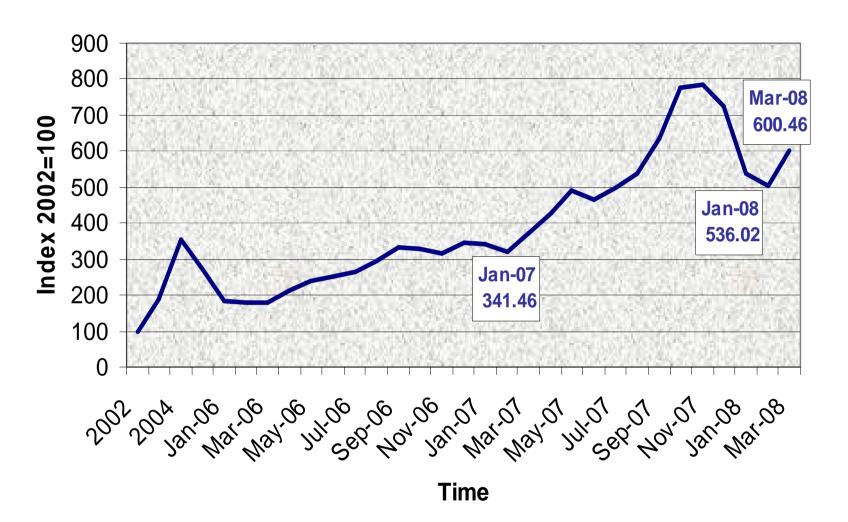
- Associated costs figures being finalized

- Updated New Requirements (excl. ISC): \$449 million
