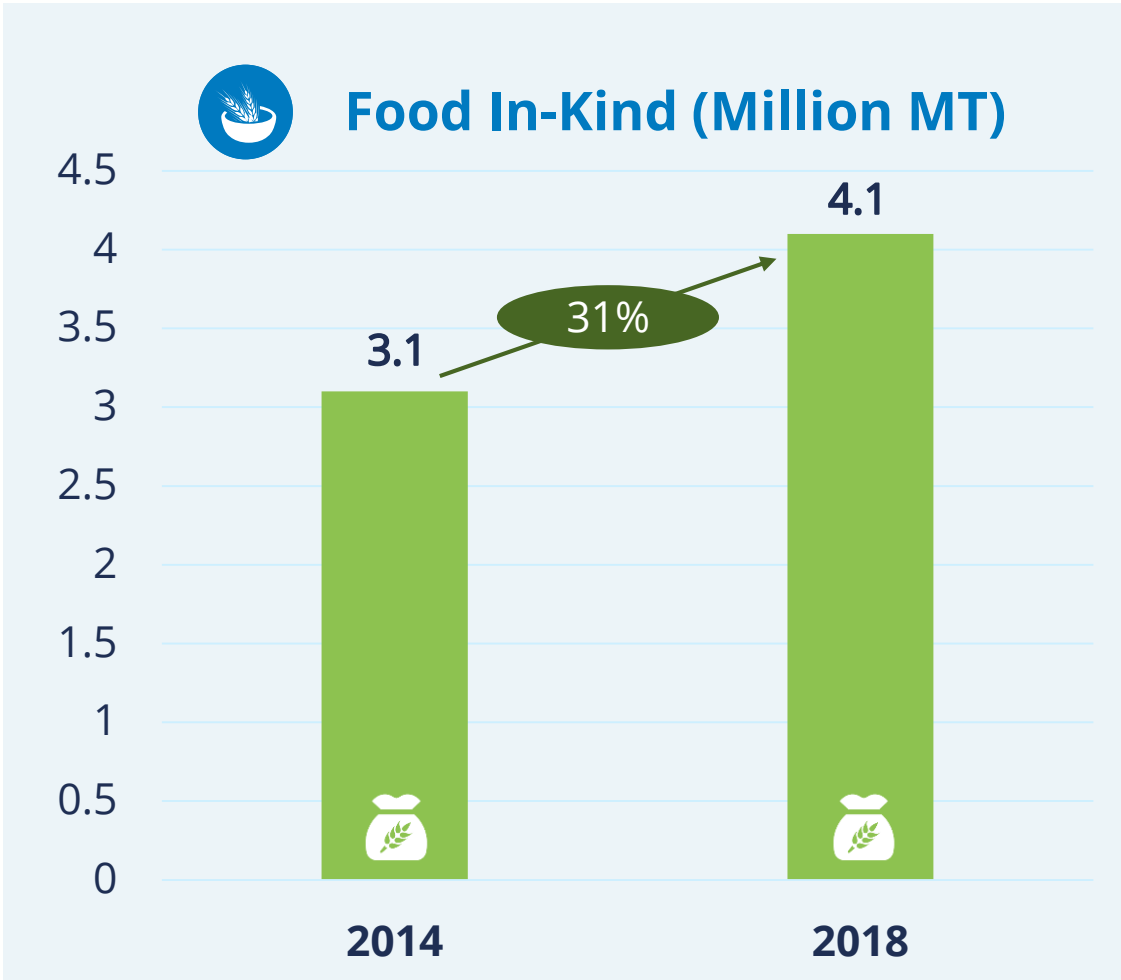
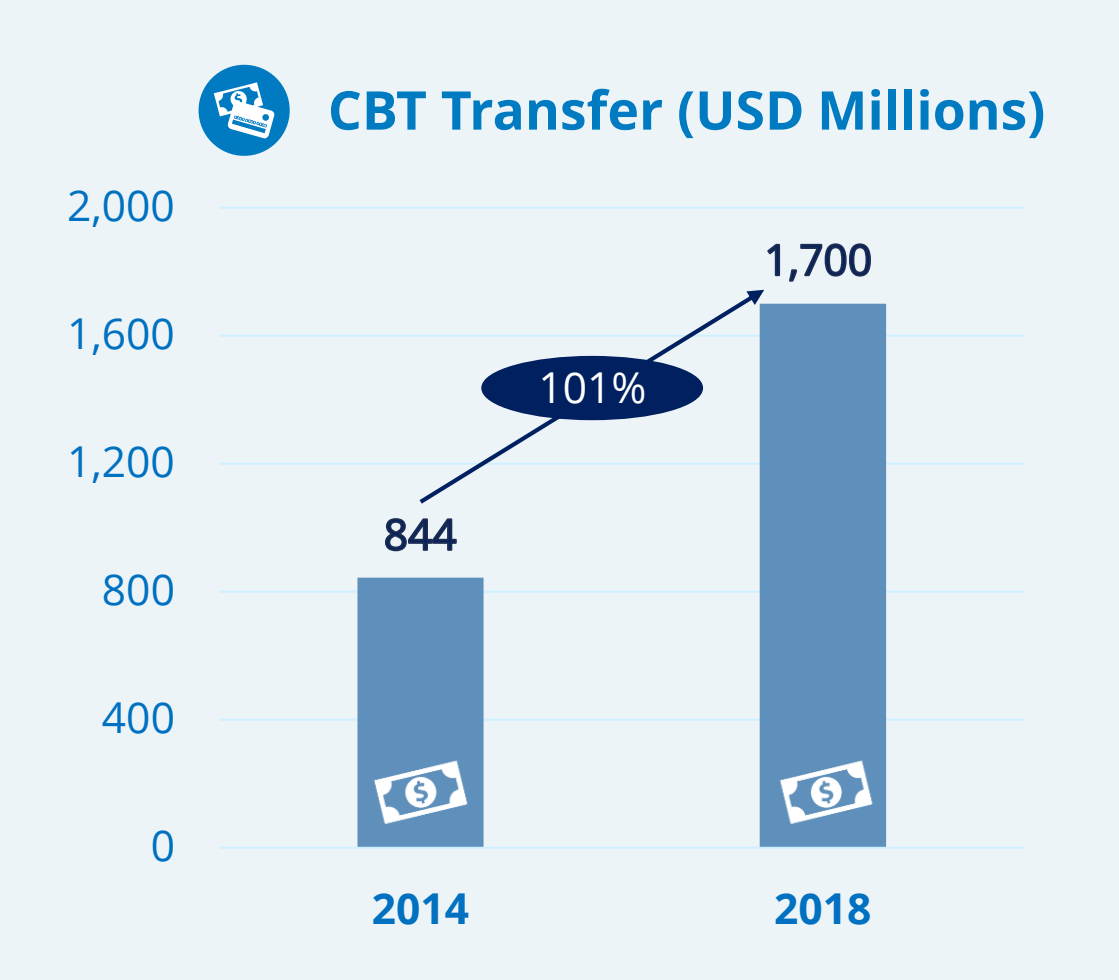

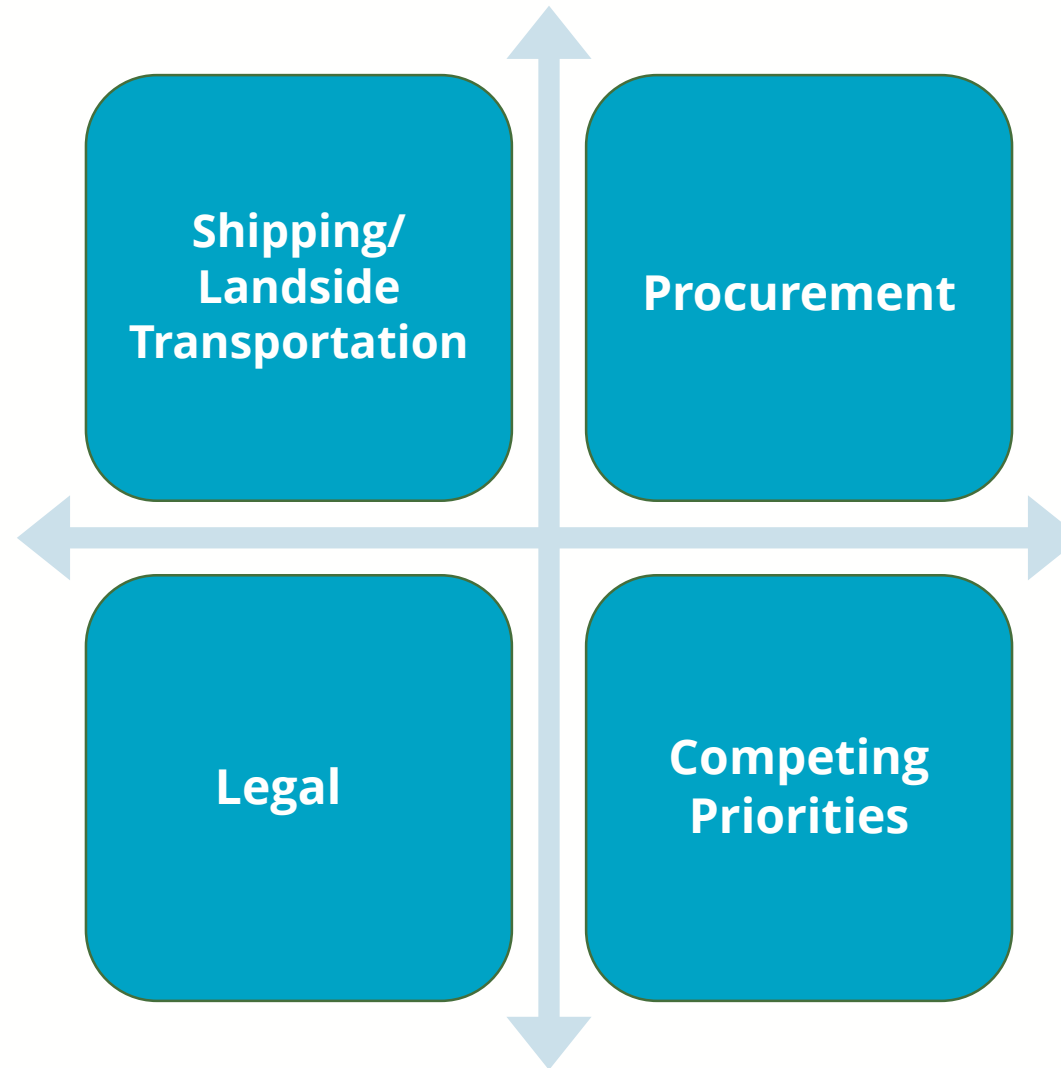
Oversight

Ensuring that processes and systems are timely and adequate to meet the needs of WFP operations



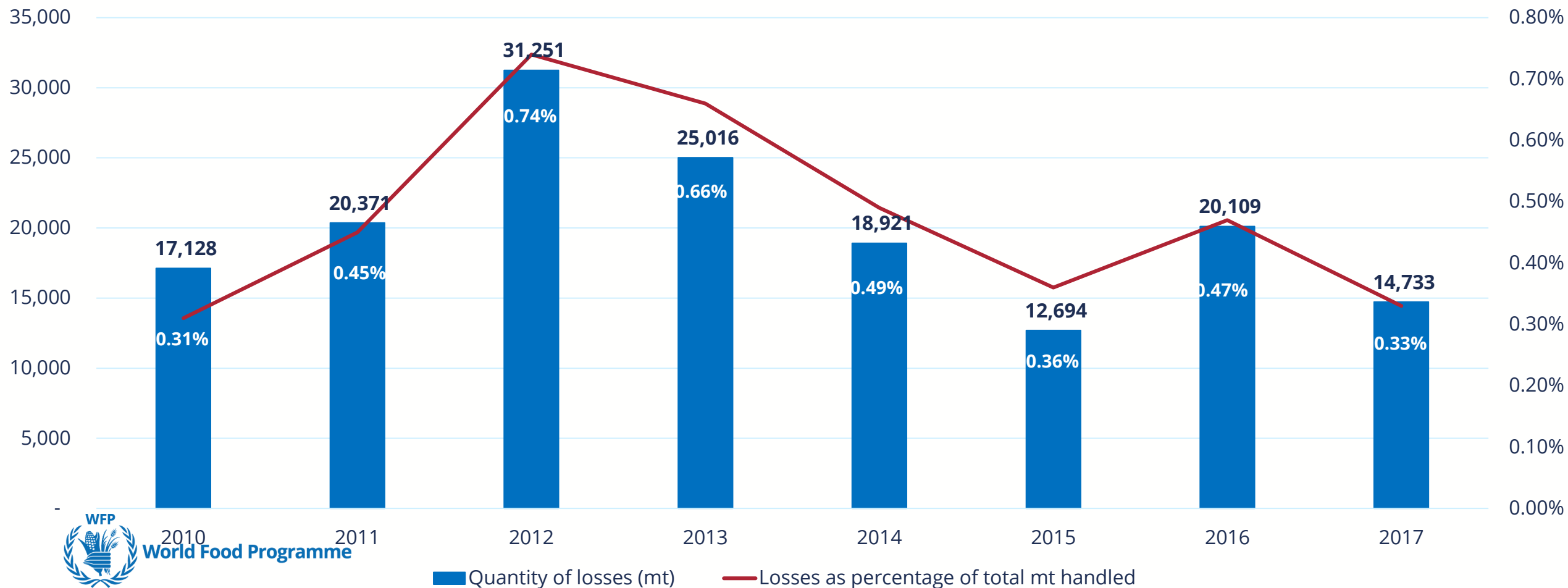
WFP Supply Chain Faces a Wide Range of Risks

Example of Risk Areas

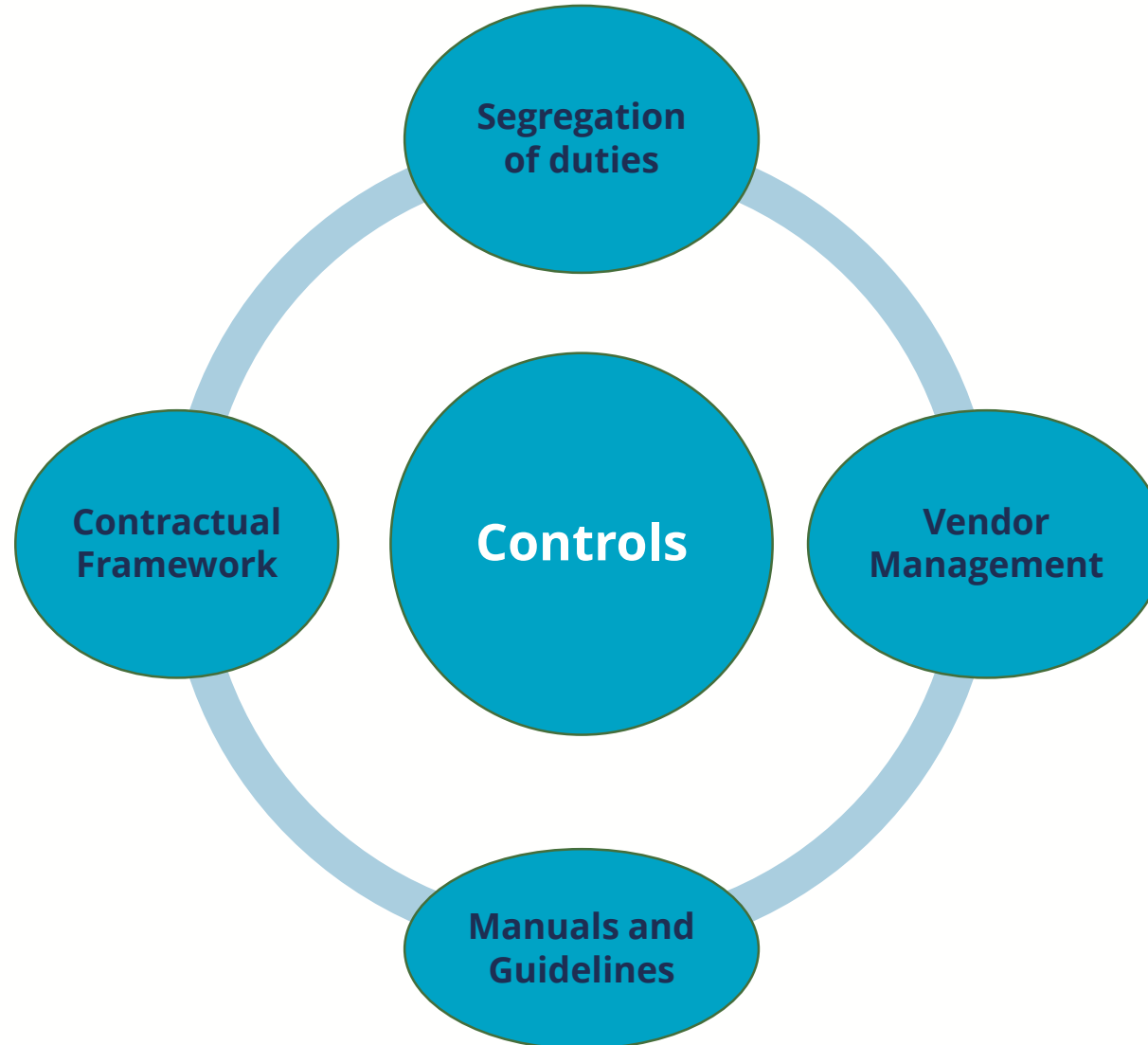


Post-Delivery Losses in 2017
