## **WFP Supply Chain**

Underpins WFP programmes around the world













36 partners served

95 countries reached

575 shipments, carrying 7,200 mt

512 organizations supported NGO





Ensuring that processes and systems are timely and adequate to meet the needs of WFP operations












#### WFP Supply Chain Faces a Wide Range of Risks


**Example of Risk Areas** 






#### **Post-Delivery Losses in 2017**

• In 2017, WFP worked concurrently on seven Level 3 emergencies. Despite these challenges, the 2017 losses were the lowest since 2011 in terms of percentage of food handled.
