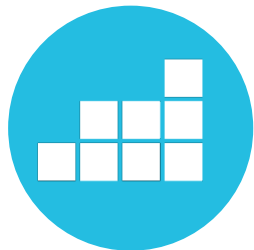

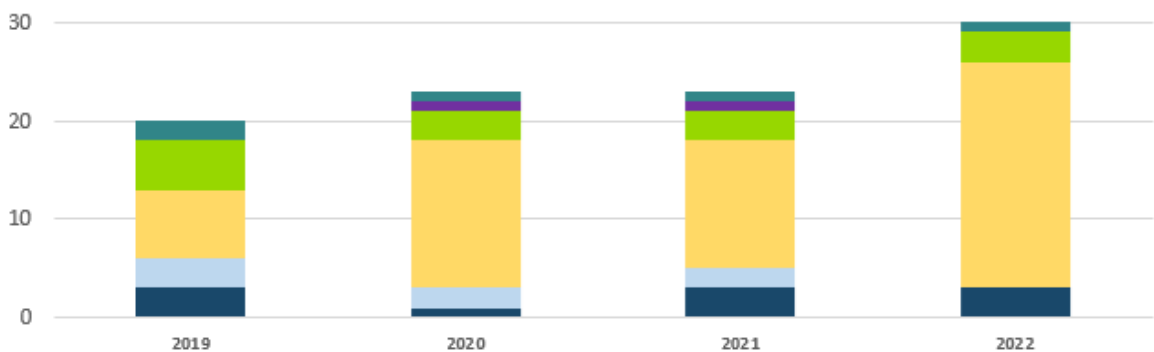

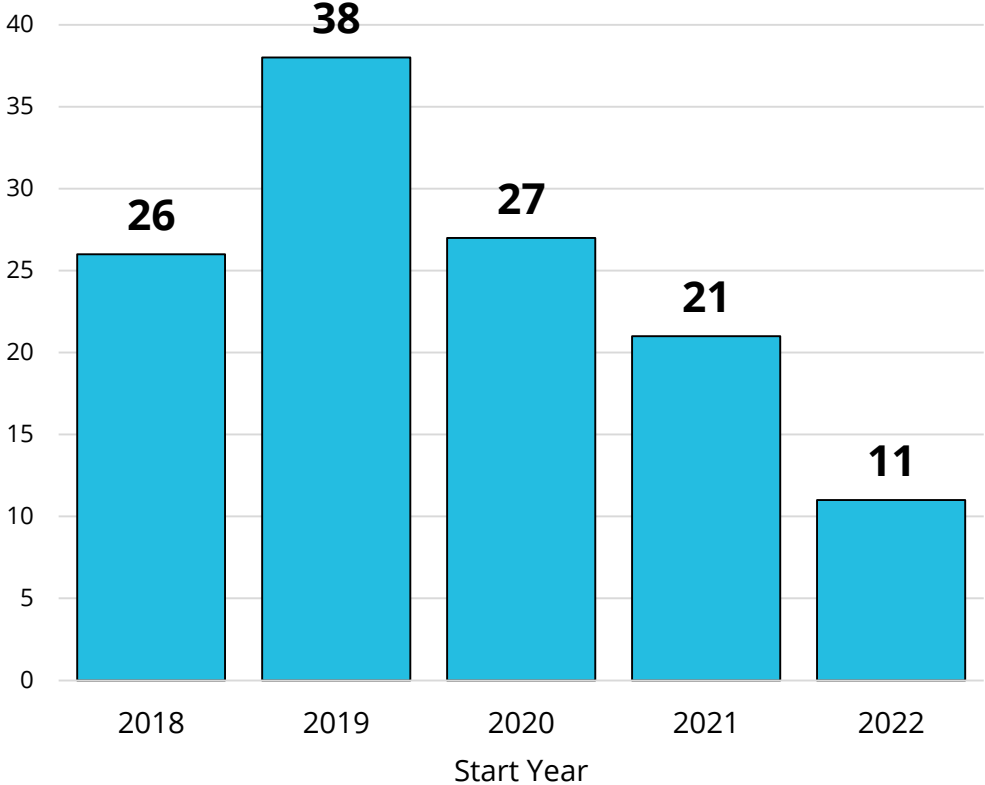

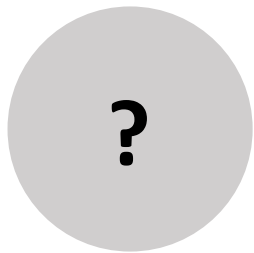

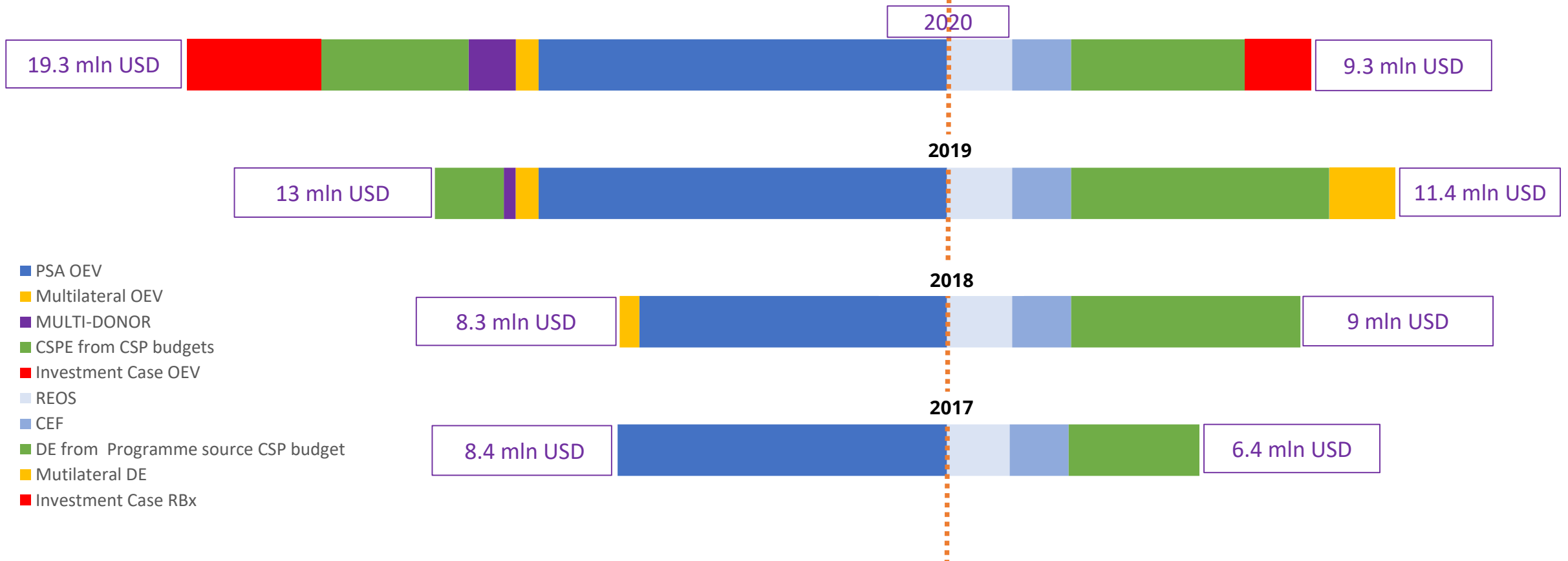

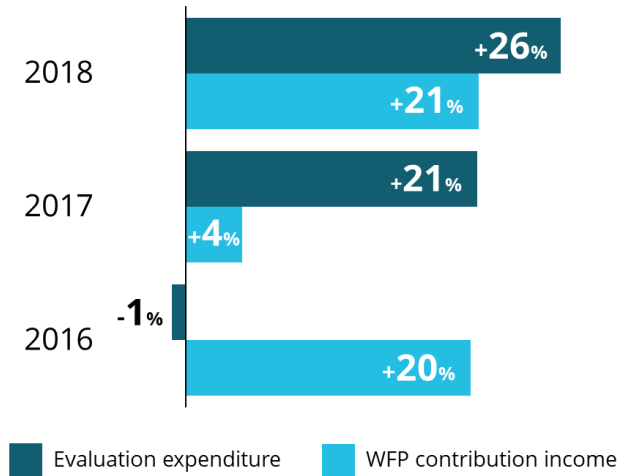

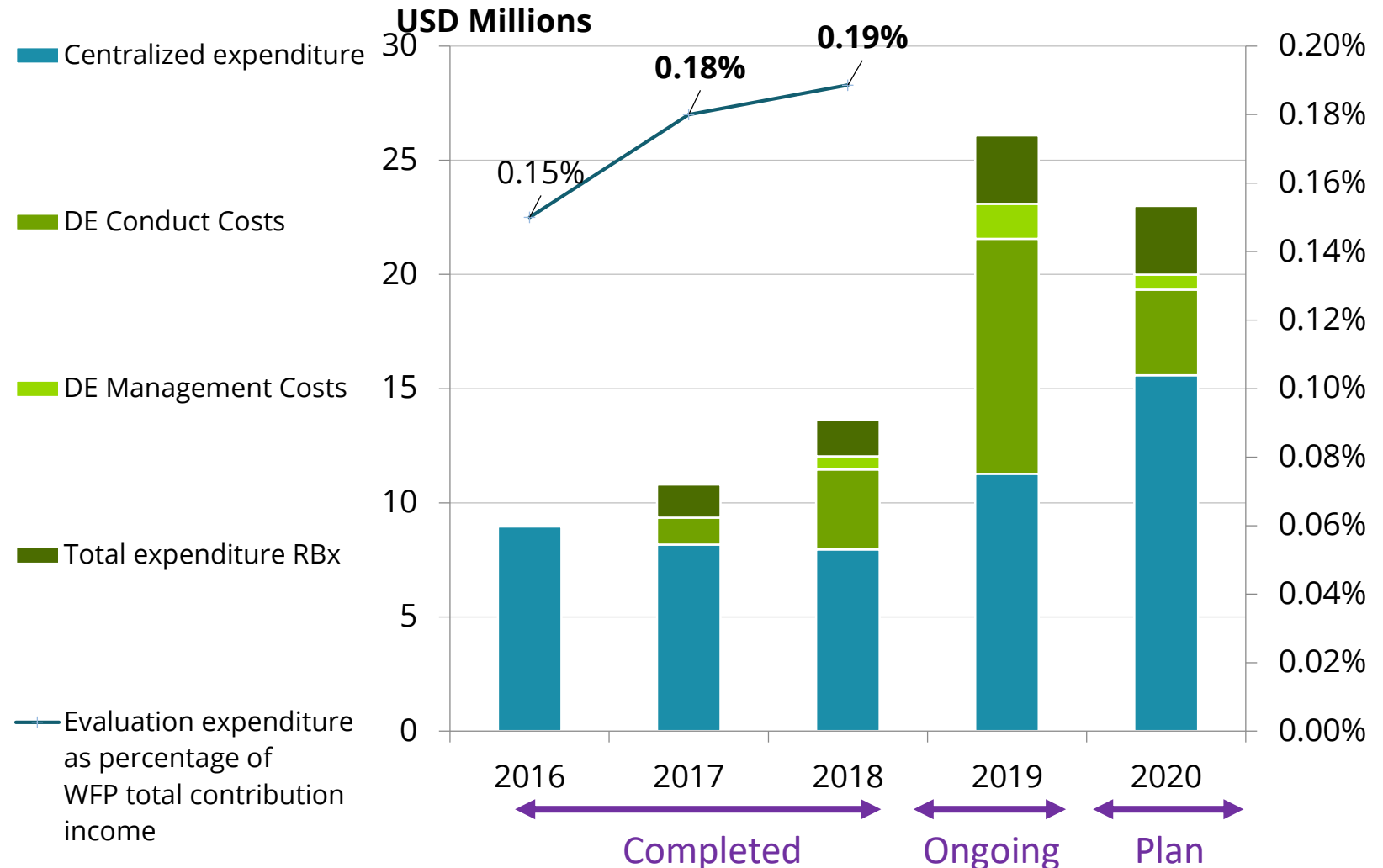


Expenditure on evaluation

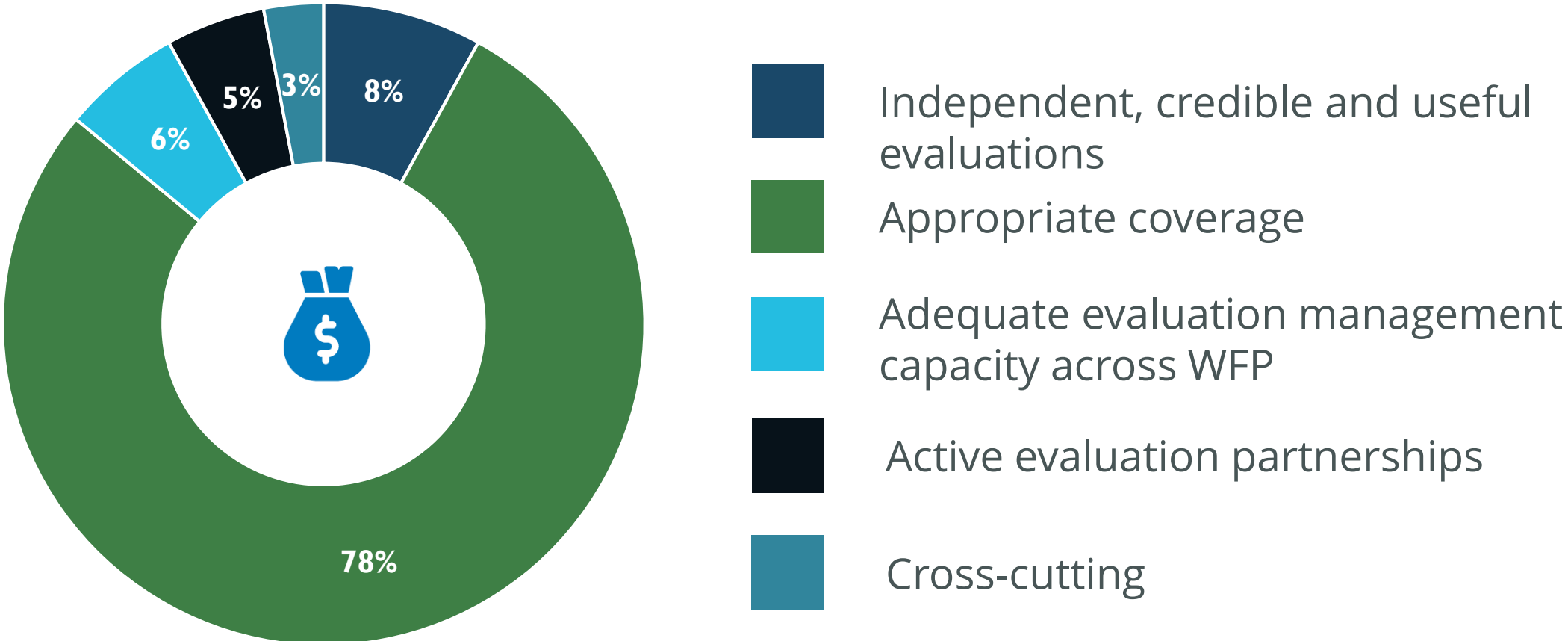
Growth rate of WFP total contribution income and evaluation expenditure, 2016–2018



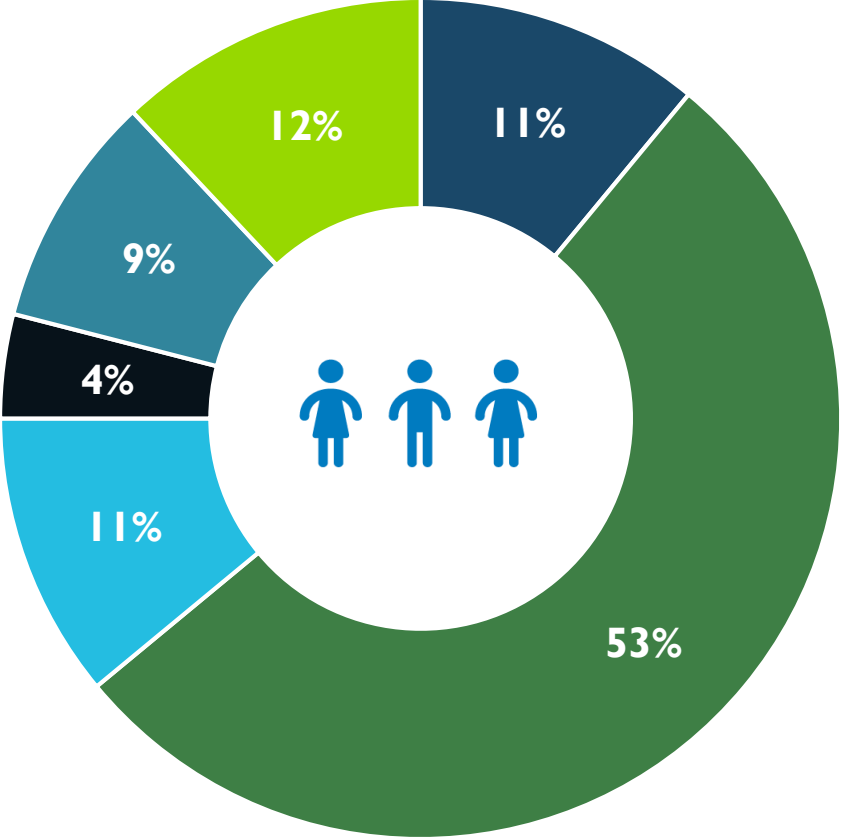
Resources for evaluation as a percentage of WFP total contribution income
