

Cyclone Projections






Tropical storms are more frequent & intense





Mozambique – Conflict



- Humanitarian situation in Cabo Delgado continues to deteriorate due to insecurity & violence
- 565,000 people have been displaced
- **WFP** has reached 400,000 people
- USD 132 million shortfall for the next six months



DRC now has more people living in crisis & emergency than any other country


Madagascar
