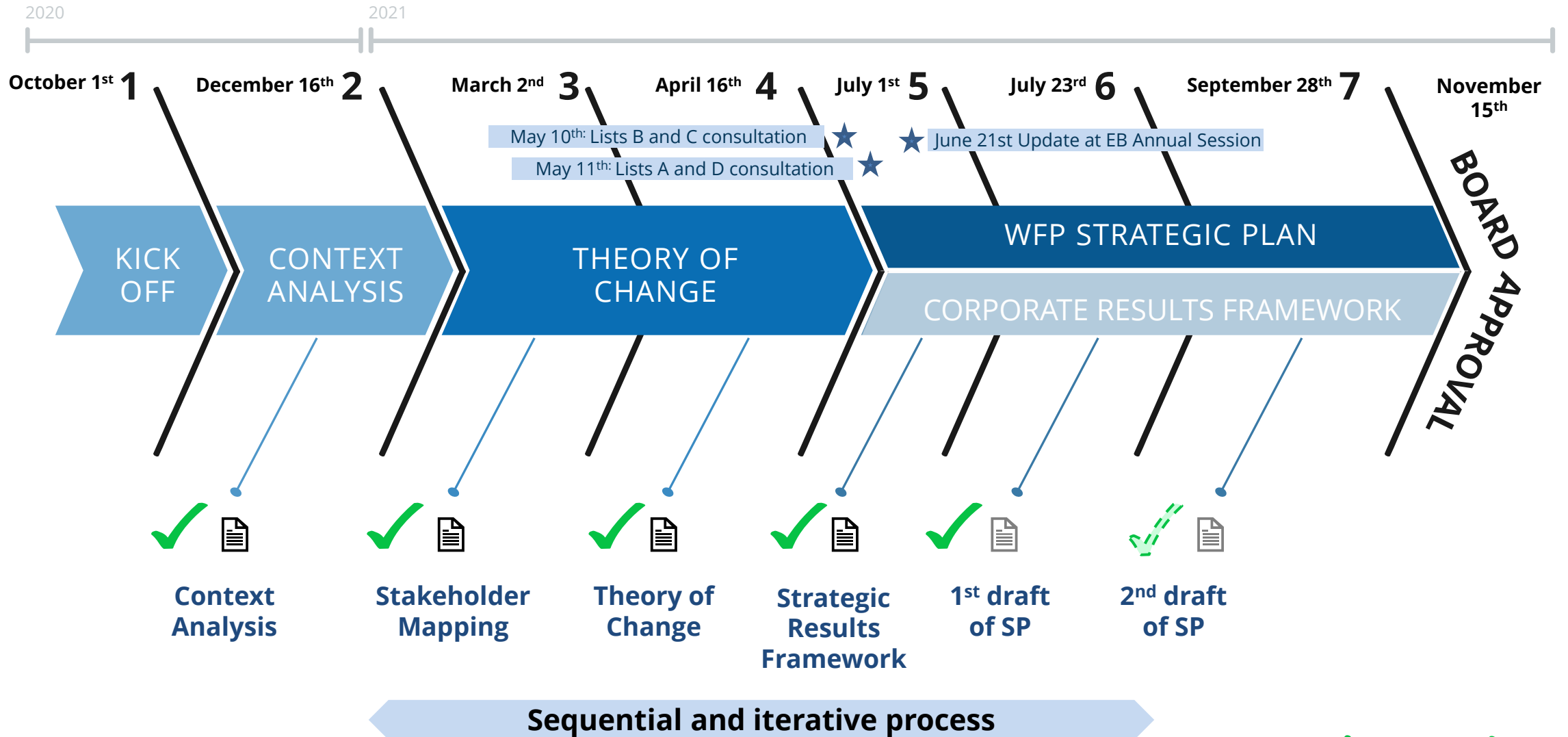

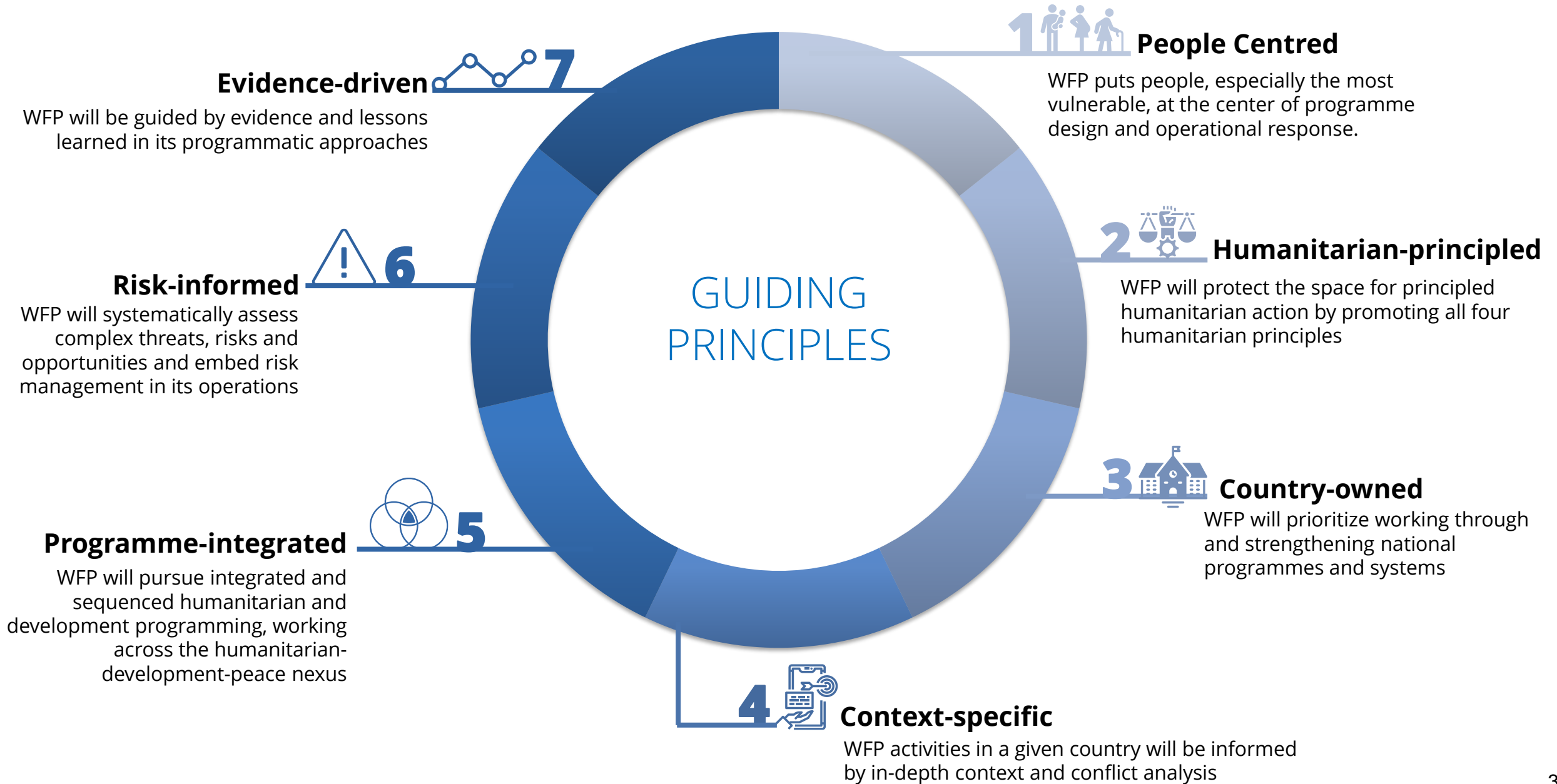

WFP will focus on better **understanding climate risks**, **scaling up and mainstreaming adaptation measures** and **harnessing climate financing**

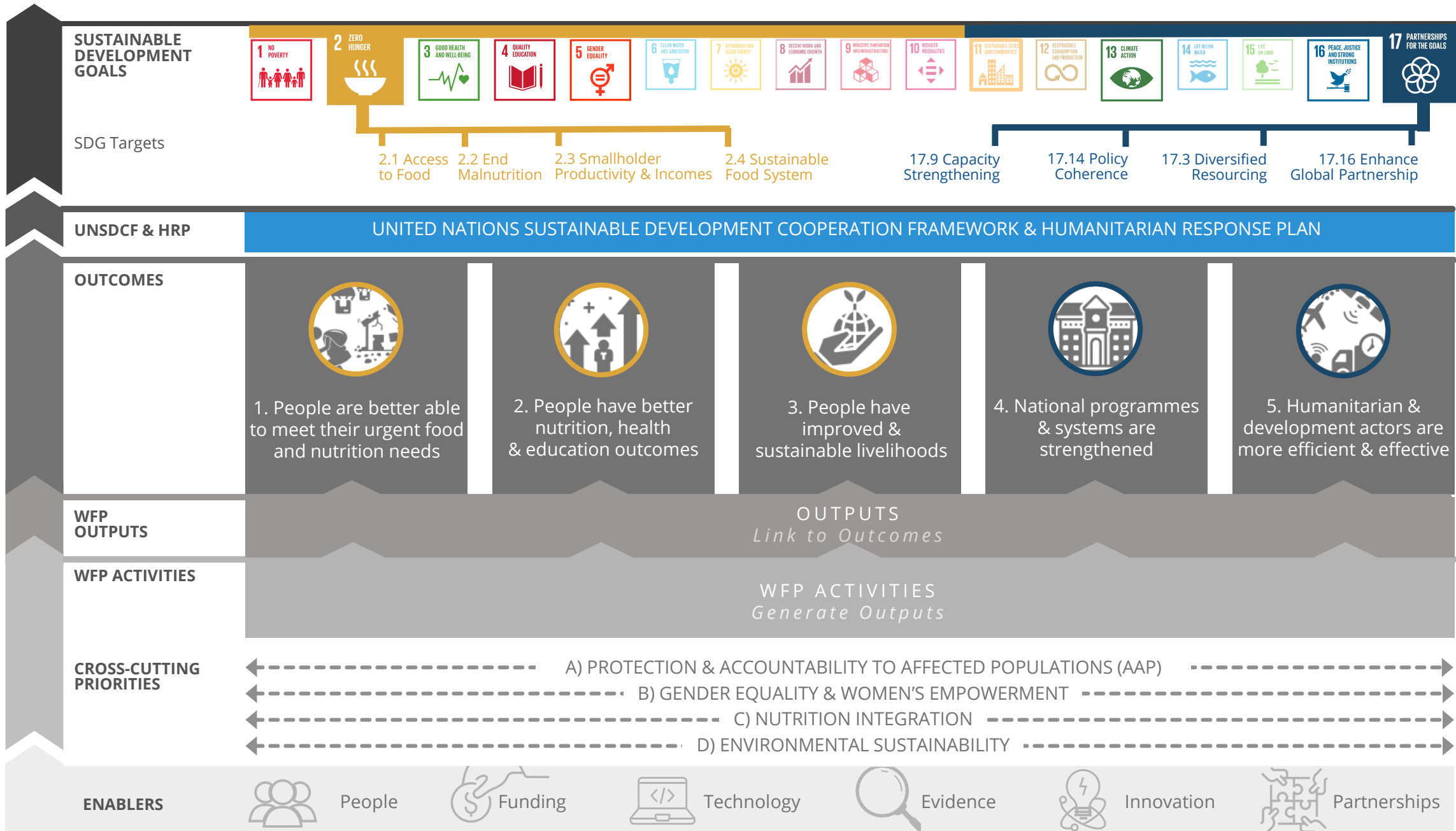


**Economic Slowdown**

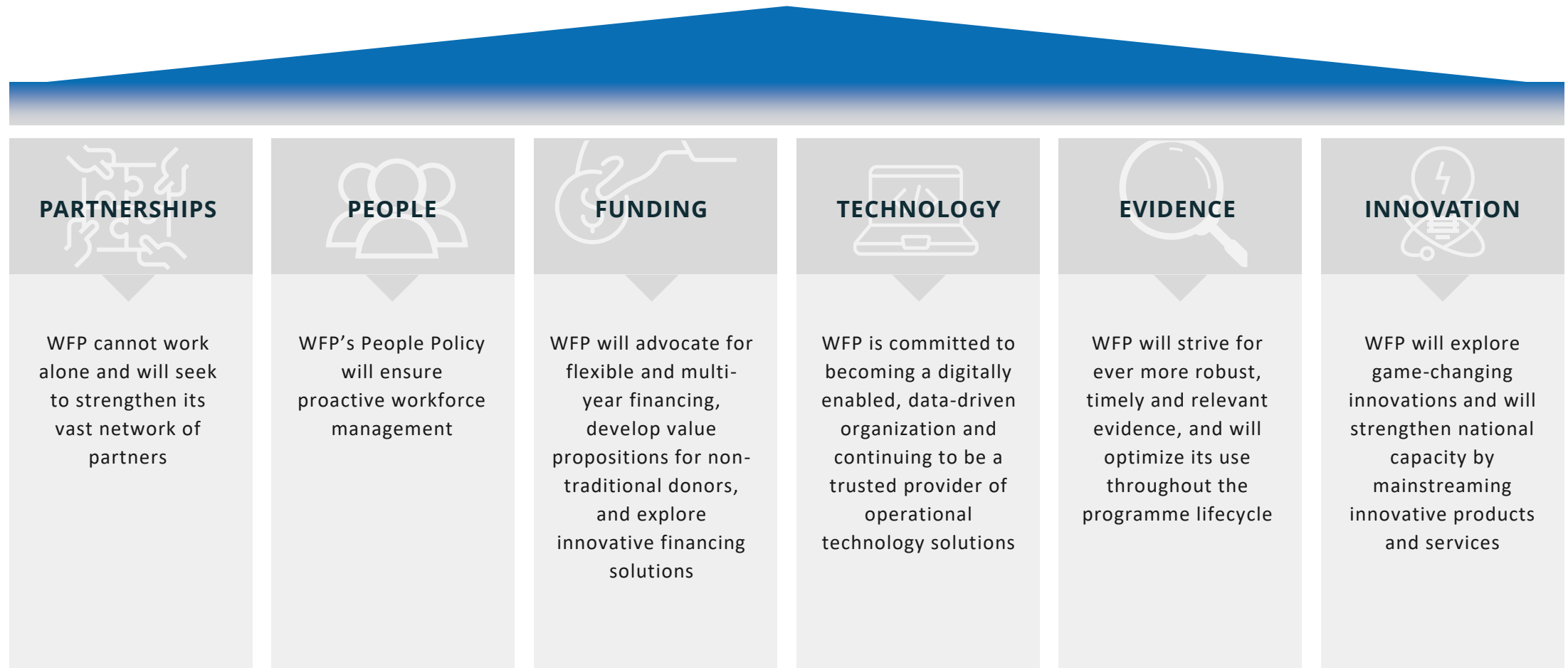
## Environmental Sustainability

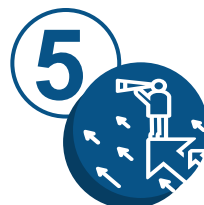
