Annotated provisional agenda

1. Adoption of the agenda

Pursuant to Rule III of the rules of procedure of the Executive Board, the Executive Director hereby presents, **for approval**, the provisional agenda of the 2021 second regular session. During the session, the Board may, by a two-thirds majority of the members present and voting, amend the agenda by deletion, addition or modification of any item.

2. Election to fill vacant positions in the Bureau and appointment of the Rapporteur

The Board shall elect Bureau members to replace representatives who have left the Bureau.

Pursuant to Rule XII and in keeping with the established methods of work, the Board may appoint a Rapporteur from among the representatives.

3. Opening remarks by the Executive Director

Under this item, the Executive Director will make an oral presentation to the Board on current and future strategic issues facing WFP. This will be followed by remarks from special and high-level guests and an interactive question and answer virtual segment.

4. Policy issues

a) WFP strategic plan (2022–2025)

Building on the findings from the mid-term review of the strategic plan (2017–2021), the WFP strategic plan (2022–2025) will enable WFP to articulate its contribution to achieving relevant goals, targets and indicators of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. The new strategic plan will also take into account opportunities and address emerging challenges based on lessons learned from policy, programme and operation evaluations and assessments, and consultations with the Board and other stakeholders. This item is presented to the Board **for approval**.

b) Update on collaboration among the Rome-based agencies^{*}

At its second regular session in 2010, the Board asked the Secretariat to report annually on Rome-based agency collaboration as a follow-up to the document entitled "Directions for collaboration among the Rome-based agencies" (WFP/EB.2/2009/11-C). The report provides a comprehensive overview on the collaboration, along with any new areas of collaboration, initiatives and partnerships for food and nutrition security. The update will be presented **for information**.

c) <u>Oral update on WFP's implementation of the outcomes of the 2021 United Nations food</u> <u>systems summit</u>*

As requested by the Secretariat at the Bureau meeting of 10 September 2021, an oral update on WFP's implementation of the outcomes of the United Nations food systems summit, will be presented to the Board **for information**.

d) <u>Update on WFP's implementation of United Nations General Assembly resolution</u> <u>72/279 (repositioning the United Nations development system)</u>*

The Secretariat will update the Board on the implementation of United Nations General Assembly resolution 72/279, on repositioning the United Nations development system to deliver on the 2030 Agenda. The update will be presented **for information**.

e) Update on the WFP disability inclusion road map

The Secretariat will update the Board on the implementation of the disability inclusion road map for 2020-2021 approved at its 2020 second regular session and will present a request to extend the road map by one year through the end of 2022. The update will be presented **for approval**.

5. Resource, financial and budgetary matters

a) WFP management plan (2022-2024)

The Board will have before it, **for approval**, the management plan for the period 2022–2024, including WFP's budget for 2022.

The Board will also have before it, **for information**, the comments and recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions of the United Nations (ACABQ) and the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) Finance Committee.

b) Appointment of the WFP External Auditor for the term 1 July 2022–30 June 2028

This paper will present to the Board, **for approval**, the recommendation of the evaluation panel for the appointment of the External Auditor of WFP for the term 1 July 2022–30 June 2028.

c) Workplan of the External Auditor

This document presents the workplan of the External Auditor, detailing the audit activities for the period 2021–2022. Adherence to international standards on auditing and proven audit methods will form the basis of the External Auditor's assurance of providing high-quality services to WFP.
