WFP's policies are the 'normative framework' in which we work

SUPPORT FOR THE FIELD

Strategic and technical guidance for Country Offices/Regional Bureaux on policy issues, high-quality implementation, and normative work

COUNTRY STRATEGIC PLANS

Country Offices design country-specific plans for their programming approach – positioning WFP with national/regional partners and drawing on WFP programme tools





Policy function

- WFP currently has over **32 policies** in effect under the 2022-2025 Strategic Plan.
- An update of the portfolio of policies is submitted annually and can be found as the "Compendium of Policies" on the EB website.
- The Policy Cycle:

 - Formulation
 - Resourcing and Roll-out
 - Evaluation







Country Strategic Plans

CSP defines WFP's entire portfolio of assistance in a country over **five years**.

CSPs undergo a formal **mid-term review** to identify corrections and a **formal evaluation towards the end** to inform future WFP engagement in that country.

Alignment with **UN reform**: our Strategic Reviews are more integrated into the **UN's Common Country Assessment**, and our CSPs aligned with the **UN Sustainable Development Cooperation Framework**.

Executive Board engagement and input is ensured through Informal Consultations and formal approval of CSPs at EB sessions
