Ambassador Carlos Bernardo Cherniak is the Permanent Representative of Argentina to FAO, IFAD and WFP, since December 2019.

He is the Chair of the G77&China-Rome Chapter (March 2021-March 2022) and Vice chair of the FAO Programme Committee, since 2020.

He is a lawyer, professor of international relations theory and a career diplomat, with a strong experience in human rights, international negotiation and cooperation.

Previously, Ambassador Carlos Bernardo Cherniak served at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, International Trade and Worship of Argentina, as Director of Parliamentary Affairs (2016-2019), Director of the Nuclear and Defense Affairs Office (2006-2010), and as Specialist Officer at the Cabinet's Office of the Under Secretary of Institutional Relations (1998-2000).

He was posted as Deputy Chief of Mission and head of the Political Office at Argentine Embassy to Italy, where he played an important role in promoting human rights and bilateral cooperation (2010-2016).

Ambassador Carlos Bernardo Cherniak has a postgraduate diploma and post-graduate certificates in International Relations (FLACSO University, Argentina; The John Hopkins University. SAIS. Bologna Center, Italy) and he is a passionate sports player (football, tennis and boxing).
