
Management response

- Recommendation one: Design the next CSP to foster links between food systems and social protection through analysis of the current portfolio and a partnership action plan, with a focus on the most disadvantaged groups
 - Actions:
 - Extensive theory of change workshop during CSP development
 - Analysis of best practices and opportunities for increasingly integrating gender equality and disability and social inclusion
 - Develop partnership action plan for next CSP
- Recommendation two: Design an evidence-based Country Capacity Strengthening (CCS) Strategy
 - Actions:
 - Conduct comprehensive national capacity needs assessment with key partners
 - Develop CCS Strategy



Management response

- Recommendation three: Support the Government to review existing nutrition programmes to develop an evidence-based, nutrition-sensitive social protection programme and continue to promote the national food fortification agenda
 - Actions:
 - With the Government, review the Mother and Child Health and Nutrition programme based on lessons learned and support to revise and expand the programme as required
 - Support the Government to review, design and test school feeding modalities
 - Work with the Government to build national capacity to produce and supply fortified rice
- Recommendation four: Continue to hand over WFP-supported schools to the national school feeding programme while supporting national capacity in terms of policy, modality and management
 - Actions:
 - Support the development of the School Education Sector Plan 2022-2031 and a five-year roadmap to hand over WFP-supported schools and build Government capacity
 - Continue advocacy efforts at all levels of government on budget allocation, including through the media and international fora



Management response

- Recommendation five: Deepen climate change and resilience building support for targeted populations through increased CCS at the local, provincial and national levels
 - Actions:
 - Provide technical assistance to build capacity of local governments to deliver inclusive climate-resilient local infrastructure and develop action plans to guide climate change adaptation and response at the local level
 - Work with relevant government bodies to design projects which integrate packages of climate change adaptation and resilience building interventions
- Recommendation six: Support the enhancement of the Government's analytical capacities for evidence-based policy formulation and operations
 - Actions:
 - Identify lessons learned from the implementation of the national food security monitoring system and develop an outline of support to enhance the Government's analytical capacity
 - Develop an internal research and monitoring strategy to guide implementation of the next CSP, outline WFP's value proposition in support of the Government and guide fundraising efforts for evidence generation
