



De-brief of resilience donor mission to Chad

Background

From 13–19 April 2024, representatives from Germany, Norway, Switzerland, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States undertook a mission to the WFP country office of Chad, focusing on resilience activities in preparation for the upcoming update of WFP’s resilience policy.

The delegation visited a total of six different resilience sites in eastern and central regions of Chad. These projects included various livelihoods activities such as water management interventions, rehabilitation of degraded land, revitalization of soil health, vegetable gardens, and plant nurseries. The projects were integrated with nutrition or (home-grown) school meal interventions. The delegation had the opportunity to meet and exchange with beneficiaries, implementing NGO partners, the United Nations Resident Coordinator, the United Nations Children’s Fund, the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees, the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, the International Fund for Agricultural Development, the World Bank, the German Agency for International Cooperation as well as regional and national authorities.

Meeting objective

The objective of this meeting is to debrief Executive Board members, observers and WFP management to inform upcoming policy consultations with concrete insights from WFP’s integrated resilience approach in the Sahel. Participants of the field mission, as well as representatives from WFP headquarters, the Regional Bureau in Dakar and the country office, will share their first-hand impressions, key takeaways and lessons learned.
