Increase the resilience of children and families facing poverty, food insecurity, and social exclusion (including due to gender and disability) Improve children's access regardless of gender and age to education and boost their ability to concentrate, participate and learn.

Support growth and improve macro- and micronutrient adequacy of a child's diet.

Provide a stable market for smallholder farmers and enhance local gender-sensitive value chains.

Help meet basic food needs, reduce short-term hunger, support continuity of education and provide income transfer incorporating protection concerns.
