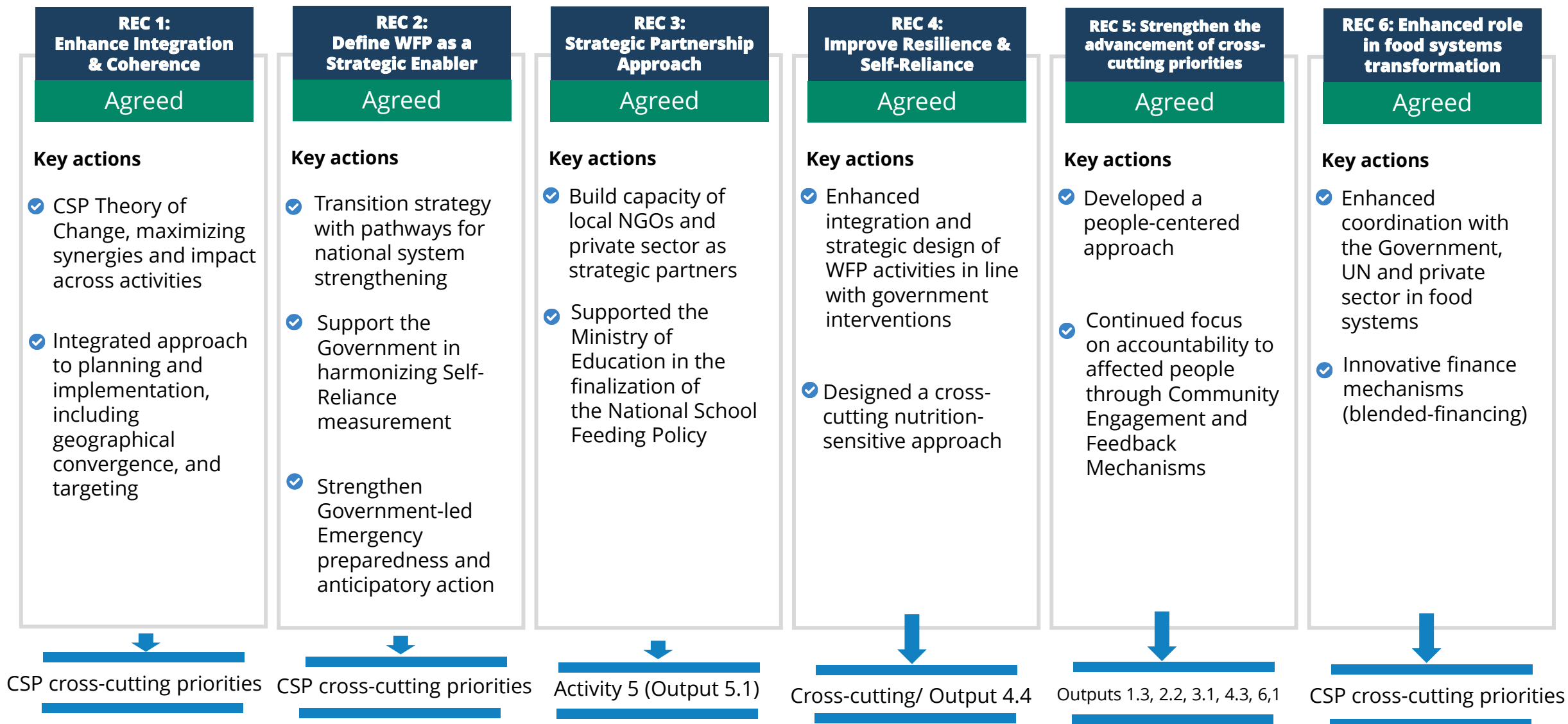

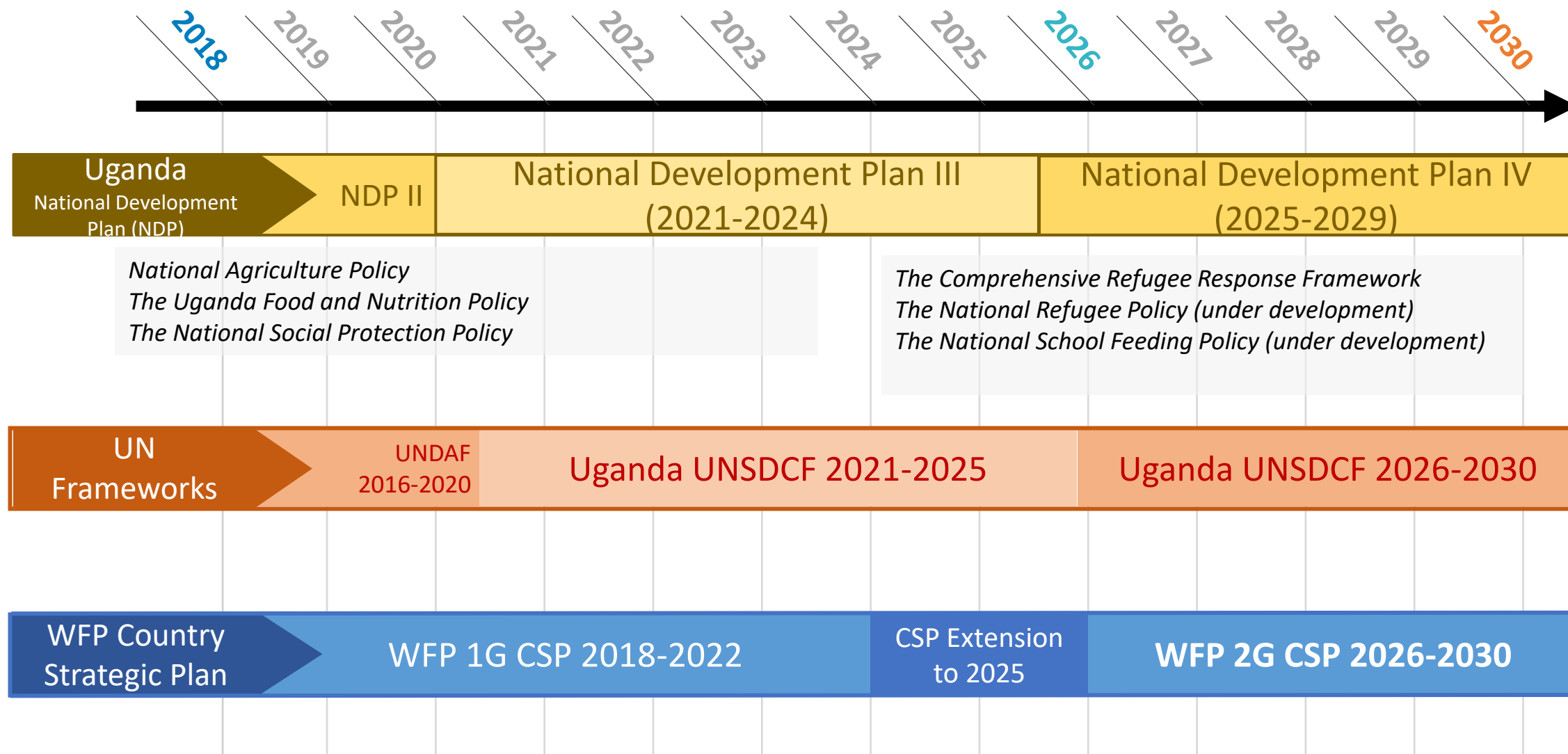

Three interconnected outcomes with an intentional focus to respond to emergencies while reducing dependence on aid

Strengthening government systems, leveraging private sector investments and partnerships

Risk-Informed, Anticipatory Programming

Malnutrition prevention

Integrated, prevention-oriented approach

Strategic Framework: Three Integrated Outcomes



Crisis Response

Vulnerable refugees and Ugandans affected by crisis have **access** to nutritious food

- ✓ Emergency food assistance
- ✓ Time-bound and prioritized assistance



Resilience Building

Vulnerable refugees and Ugandans benefit from **strengthened food systems** and diversified livelihoods that enhance healthy diets and resilience

- ✓ Asset creation and skills development
- ✓ Income diversification and market linkages



Systems Strengthening

Government institutions have **improved capacity** for social protection and disaster risk management.

- ✓ School Meals Programme
- ✓ Technical assistance, policy support, and evidence generation
