- Population 280 million
- Member of G20, ASEAN, BRICS and Global Alliances
- Largest economy in Southeast Asia – Vision of Golden Indonesia 2045
- Commitment to global sustainable development



- Ring of Fire: Extreme weather events
- Persistent triple burden of malnutrition
- Expensive nutritious diets



- Government Free Nutritious Meals (31B USD, 83 million persons, including 66 million school children)
- Solid national emergency preparedness response system
