Insight 1: WFP strategic positioning

- **Leveraged WFP's comparative advantages** in emergency response, logistics & food security and nutrition
- WFP **adapted to increased needs & funding shortfalls** by introducing biometric registration for refugees and adjusting ration sizes and duration of assistance



Insight 2: Results

- **Improved food security & nutrition outcomes** for crisis affected communities in Karamoja but had limited effect for refugees
- **Strengthened national and local capacities** in shock-responsive social protection systems
- **Gender sensitive activities addressing equal participation & empowerment**, but root causes of gender inequalities are still a challenge



Insight 3: Challenges

- **Resource shortfalls & earmarking** hampering effectiveness and sustainability
- Agricultural **market support activities** in Karamoja, and school feeding still **dependent on WFP funding and implementation capacity**
- **Limited engagements with the private sector** in support of food systems development and transformation
