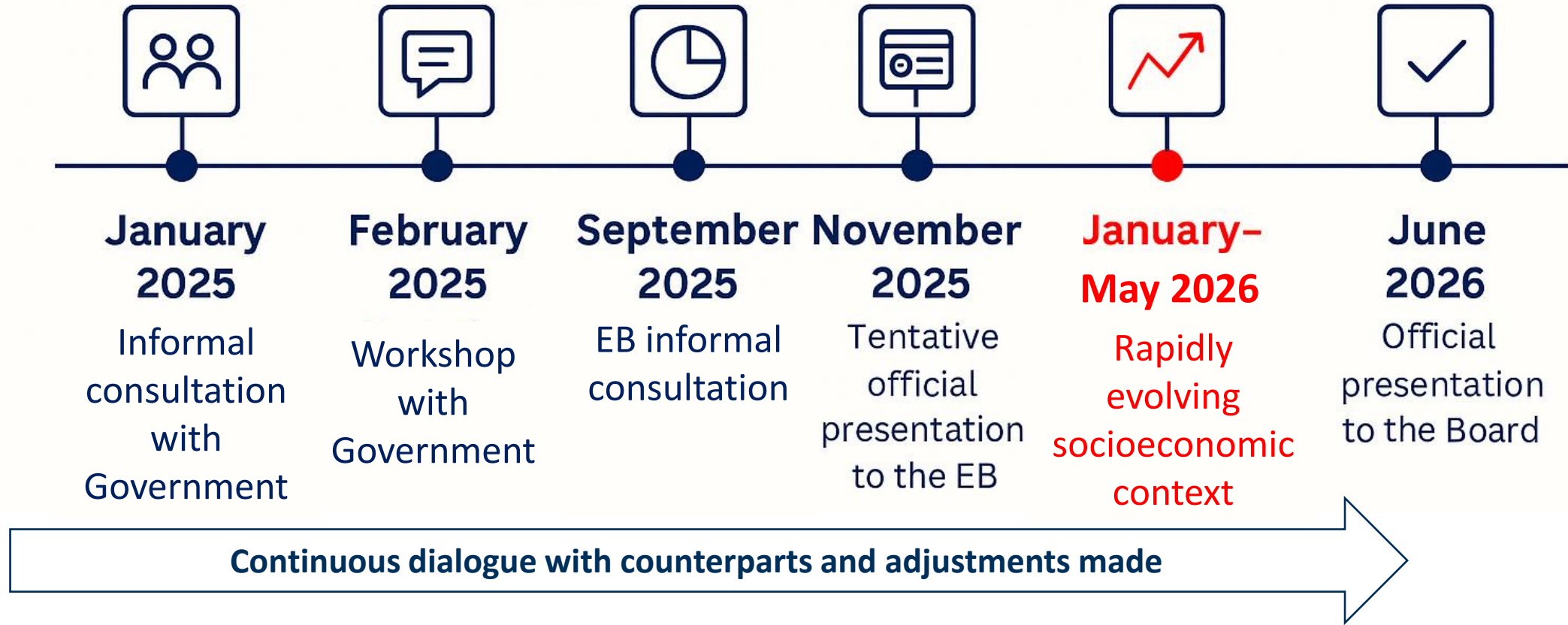

Evolving context:

- Worsening energy crisis, with acute shortages of fuel and electricity
- Increasing operational difficulties for humanitarian actors, affecting access, logistics and the delivery of assistance
- Increased socio-economic vulnerabilities, including growing food security concerns

**Activity 1:
Assistance to people
affected by crises**



- Establishment of pre-positioned strategic reserves, including food and non-food, for rapid disaster response.
- Distribution of both food in kind and complementary items to affected people.
- Advance support with hot meals and cooking utensils.
- Strengthening institutional capacities

- Improve value chains by connecting smallholder farmers to institutional markets.
=> Focus on women and youth
- Improve resilience through early warnings, crop protection, sustainable resource management, and disaster insurance.
