Statements

There will be no lists of speakers prepared. Delegates wishing to intervene are invited to press the button to indicate using their microphone. Due to time constraints, all interventions will be limited to **3 minutes**, regardless of the type of statement. A timer will be displayed on the screen, and **microphones will be cut off** once the allotted time has elapsed.

Languages

According to the DGACM of the UN Secretariat, **meetings fully held in-person receive 3 hours of simultaneous interpretation** in six languages. A short extension of the meeting is possible; however, interpretation services will not be available beyond the allocated time. A **maximum extension of 20 minutes** may be granted, if required.
