According to UNHCR and ARRA projections, reflecting current registrations and inflows, the Somali caseload will increase to 51,629 by 2009, with a further increase of 36 percent by the end of this PRRO due to continued conflict in Somalia. The number of Eritrean refugees, projected to be 37,633 by 2009, is expected to increase by 39 percent by 2011 due to, among other things, the unresolved border issues between Ethiopia and Eritrea. In contrast, repatriation of the Sudanese refugees is projected to continue, resulting in a 70 percent decrease by the end of this PRRO. All Kenyans registered as refugees are expected to repatriate by 2011.
