

# **INTRODUCTION**

1. The Immediate Response Account (IRA) was established in December 1991 by the Committee on Food Aid Policies and Programmes (CFA) with an original target level of US\$30 million. This level was later increased in 1995 to US\$35 million by the CFA, and to US\$70 million in 2004 at the Board's Second Regular Session. The IRA is a multilateral fund facility that enables WFP to provide immediate food aid including logistical and other non-food costs in an emergency situation. Since its inception, the IRA has repeatedly proved its value as one of the most effective relief response mechanisms.

- 2. In considering the document "Review of the Immediate Response Account (IRA)" (WFP/EB.3/2004/12-A), the Board requested the Secretariat to submit a formal annual information paper on the use of the IRA.
- 3. The purpose of this document is to provide information on the use of the IRA during 2006.
- 4. The Secretariat will continue to periodically update Board members on the use of the IRA through the publication WFP's Operational Requirements, Shortfalls and Priorities, which is issued three times a year concurrently with each Board session.

### Facts about the IRA

Allocations from the IRA fund are made as loans to eligible operations in anticipation of receiving donor contributions. If no such donations are received, as sometimes occurs in life-threatening situations, the loan is deemed to be a permanent, non-reimbursable grant from the IRA.

The IRA serves as both a replenishable and a revolving fund. "Revolving" means that funds allocated from the IRA to an operation may subsequently be reimbursed to the IRA account with donor contributions received for that operation. Contributions that are used to revolve the IRA are accounted for and reported under the operation to which the donor pledged them.

Donor contributions made directly to the IRA facility replenish the Fund.

In-kind contributions or contributions with donor conditions such as bag markings restrict the possibility of revolving the IRA.

# USE OF THE IRA, 1 JANUARY - 31 DECEMBER 2006

- 5. The significance of the IRA as one of WFP's effective mechanisms in responding swiftly to emerging and rapidly increasing humanitarian needs continued to be demonstrated in 2006. It was a historic year for the IRA with the largest amount of funding provided since its inception in 1991, including a transfer to the IRA of US\$20 million from the WFP PSA Equalization Account, approved at the 2006 Annual Session of the Executive Board. This significant increase in funding supported an unprecedented level of allocations in the amount of US\$136 million.
- 6. Assistance was provided to 58 relief projects including eight Special Operations (SOs), and country directors under delegated authority approved ten immediate response emergency operations (EMOPs) for which funds were made available within 48 hours. The Horn of Africa operations made significant use of the IRA and were allocated over



US\$70 million allowing WFP to respond to the natural and civil crises that affected the region. An allocation of approximately US\$18 million was made to operations in the Great Lakes region (Burundi, Democratic Republic of Congo and Rwanda), assisting refugees, returnees and those affected by conflict, and US\$12 million allowed WFP to respond promptly in Lebanon with logistical and food support to the conflict-affected population. Timely assistance was also provided for operations in Algeria, Angola, Central African Republic, Chad, Colombia, Côte d'Ivoire, Indonesia, Iraq, Mauritania, Nepal, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Tanzania and Timor-Leste.


7. The IRA operates in collaboration with the United Nations Central Emergency Response Fund (CERF) to assure WFP's response to life-threatening situations and under-funded emergencies. The CERF has become an increasingly important source of funds for WFP in 2006, with procedures developed to ensure that the focus of the IRA and CERF allocations are complementary rather than overlapping.

8. The US\$136.1 million of approved allocations in 2006 is a 31 percent increase over 2005. The amount revolved into the account in 2006 totalled US\$82.6 million, a 30 percent increase over 2005, and helped ensure that WFP was able to continue to advance substantial funds to operations in need.


