19 February 2007

Election of the Bureau and Appointment of the Rapporteur

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure of the Board, the Board elected Mr James Melanson (Canada, List D) as President for a one-year term.

With regard to the appointment of the Vice-President, lack of consensus among Board members led to a vote in which the List A nomination for the post was narrowly rejected. List A subsequently nominated H.E. José Eduardo Dantas Ferreira Barbosa (Cape Verde), who was unanimously elected Vice-President.

The representatives of: India, Mr Ramalingam Parasuram (List B), Colombia, H.E. Sabas Pretelt de la Vega (List C), and Slovenia, H.E. Bojana Hocevar (List E) were elected as members of the Bureau, representing the other three WFP electoral lists for a one-year term.

In accordance with Rule XII of its Rules of Procedure, the Board appointed Mr Zakariaou Adam Maiga (Niger, List A) Rapporteur of the First Regular Session of 2007.

2007/EB.1/2 Annual Report for 2006 to ECOSOC and FAO Council

The Board approved the Annual Report for 2006 to the United Nations Economic and Social Council and the Council of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (WFP/EB.1/2007/4). In accordance with its decision 2004/EB.A/11 of 24 May 2004, the Board requested that the Annual Report be forwarded to the United Nations Economic and Social Council and the Council of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, along with the Board's decisions and recommendations for 2006 and the present decision.

POLICY ISSUES

2007/EB.1/3 Ending Child Hunger and Undernutrition Initiative

Having considered the document "Ending Child Hunger and Undernutrition Initiative: Global Framework for Action" (WFP/EB.2/2006/4-A) and approved decision 2006/EB.2/2 and subsequently reviewed the document "Ending Child Hunger and Undernutrition Initiative" (WFP/EB.1/2007/5-A), the Board, in recognizing the importance for ECHUI to support the national policies and programmes:

- noted the UNICEF Executive Board's decisions of 18 January 2007, the status of the Partners Group, the milestones for 2007–2008, the corresponding timetable for developing the Partners Group work plan and responsibilities, the draft work plan for ECHUI, including the terms of reference for the Partners Group, the Steering Committee and the ECHUI secretariat;
- authorized the Secretariat to continue developing ECHUI as outlined in the Global Framework for Action (see Addendum WFP/EB.1/2007/5-A/Add. 1), including the minimum funding from non-PSA sources required for further refining of the workplan and milestones, for developing the Partners Group, and for preparing the ground for the Steering Committee and the Secretariat, recognizing UNICEF's co-leadership role;
- approved WFP's role in the 2007–2008 workplan with a first year budget for WFP of US\$1.31 million from non-PSA funds, contingent upon approval by UNICEF's Executive Board of UNICEF's participation in ECHUI with a matching contribution of funds for the joint Secretariat.

The Board:

- (i) authorized the Executive Director to fund variances between standard staff rates and actual staff expenditures at the end of each financial period, as follows:
 - a) variances arising on positions funded from PSA to be funded from (or refunded to) the PSA Equalization Account;
 - b) variances arising on positions funded from non-PSA sources to be funded from (or refunded to) the General Fund; and
 - c) WFP to report to the Board the treatment of both positive and negative variances at the end of each financial period;
- (ii) approved up to US\$6.9 million for a general service staff salary increase to be funded from the PSA Equalization Account;
- (iii) approved a revised regular PSA appropriation of US\$371.8 million and a revised property, plant and equipment capital appropriation of US\$4.0 million, as follows:
