### 2006/EB.A/3 Annual Performance Report for 2005

The Board approved the Annual Performance Report for 2005 (WFP/EB.A/2006/4 + Corr.1), noting that it provided a comprehensive record of WFP's performance for the year.



### **POLICY ISSUES**

### 2006/EB.A/4 Engagement in Poverty-Reduction Strategies

The Board recommended that WFP:

- a) engage with national authorities in the Poverty-Reduction Strategy process in partnership with FAO, IFAD, the United Nations country teams and other development partners to ensure due attention to food insecurity and hunger in the short, medium and long term;
- b) integrate into PRRO and development project reports information on how they contribute to national poverty-reduction strategies;
- c) prepare detailed guidance on WFP's engagement in national poverty-reduction strategy processes; and
- d) consider how best to build national governments and WFP staff capacity, in line with WFP's mandate and Strategic Objectives, and taking account of competing resource needs and operational priorities.

### 2006/EB.A/5 The Role and Application of Economic Analysis in WFP

In considering the paper "The Role and Application of Economic Analysis in WFP" (WFP/EB.A/2006/5-C), the Board noted the importance for WFP of integrating economic analysis in relation to its programmes and operations.

The Board recommended that:

- WFP take the necessary steps to ensure that the role and application of economic analysis be mainstreamed within the organization in relation to its programmes and operations, and report on progress and associated costs in future Annual Performance Reports;
- b) WFP continue to invest in its in-house economic analysis capability, in close cooperation with National Governments, as another tool for designing its programmes and operations and drawing to the maximum extent possible on the existing capacities of all partners concerned; and
- c) WFP intensify its strategic partnership with FAO, IFAD and other organizations to exploit synergies and avoid duplication of analytical efforts. To this end, the Board requested a written report on the details of the strategic partnership, including the division of labour among the participating organizations and taking into account the observations made by Board members on the document to be submitted at the November 2006 Board Session.



# 2006/EB.A/6 Global Task Team Recommendations on Improving AIDS Coordination among Multilateral Institutions and International Donors

The Board:

- a) endorsed the recommendations of the Global Task Team on Improving AIDS Coordination among Multilateral Institutions and International Donors;
- b) strongly supported the emphasis on support for country-level action and strengthening national responses within the context of the GTT recommendations; and
- c) endorsed the United Nations Technical Support Division-of-Labour Matrix.

The Board.

recognizing a) that the conclusions of the "Full Report of the Evaluation of the Business Process Review" highlight the benefits achieved through the nine pilot operations, b) that the BPR achieved its two major objectives of maximizing the utilization of contributions and making food available on a more timely basis, c) that US\$167.5 million of the US\$185.5 million authorized in working-capital loans has been repaid, with no write-offs to date, and d) that the evaluation report identified areas for improvement that were being addressed by the Secretariat, which was developing an automated tool, preparing guidance materials and reviewing the internal advance mechanisms,

authorized the Secretariat to extend the BPR model as appropriate, with no increase to the overall working-capital threshold of US\$180 million, to those country offices that had implemented the business building blocks to support the BPR system and had the capacity to benefit from it;

### 2006/EB.A/25 Draft Country Programme Egypt 10450.0 (2007–2011)

The Board endorsed draft country programme Egypt 10450.0, Enabling Livelihoods, Nutrition and Food Security, 2007–2011 (WFP/EB.A/2006/8/4 + Corr.1).

In line with WFP's General Rules, the "countries of concentration" policy and the limited availability of resources for development, the budget for Board approval was capped at approximately US\$8.0 million — US\$1.6 million a year for five years. These resources would cover 20,904 mt of food for 80,150 beneficiaries.

The Board also endorsed WFP's strategy for an expanded country programme for a total of US\$44.1 million, considering ongoing reform efforts by the Government of Egypt and the urgent need to improve government food-assisted development activities. WFP would seek additional funding beyond regular pledges and contributions to support Egypt in meeting these needs. The expanded country programme would assist approximately 396,000 beneficiaries with direct food support, and would enable millions more poor people to secure food and other basic services under enhanced government safety-net programmes, facilitating a smooth phase-out of WFP assistance by 2011.

The Board authorized the Secretariat to formulate a country programme, taking into account the comments of Board members.

The Board took note of the "Progress Report on the Ethiopia Drought Insurance Pilot Project" (WFP/EB.A/2006/10-A/Rev.1). It authorized the Executive Director to continue analysis of the Ethiopia pilot project and preparatory work on a work plan and budget for an extension of the first Ethiopia pilot project into a second phase.

The Board also requested the Executive Director to examine the feasibility of a potential expansion of the drought insurance portfolio into commercially viable risk-management strategies.

The Board requested the Secretariat to investigate the most suitable partners and institutional home to pursue such work.

The Board requested an informal consultation on the above subjects in September 2006, the results of which will serve as basis for presentation to the Board's Second Regular Session of 2006.



At the Second Regular Session of 2006, the Board will consider reports on progress in the Ethiopia pilot project, possible further drought pilot projects on a case-by-case basis subject to the identification of funding sources, and the broader issue of suitable partnerships and an institutional home for this work. These matters will be presented in the form of a work plan and budget for 2007 for Board approval.

The Secretariat will provide the membership with a final report on the current Ethiopia pilot project at the First Regular Session of 2007, or the Second Regular Session of 2006, as appropriate.
