Budget Increases to Development Activities Approved by the Executive Director (1 January–31 December 2016)

- 1. This paper outlines development activities and budgetary increases approved by the Executive Director under her delegated authority between 1 January and 31 December 2016.
- 2. In accordance with Executive Board decisions, the Executive Director's delegated authority with regard to the development activities category includes:
 - Approval of development projects and budget increases for development projects with a food value which does not exceed USD 3 million;
 - Reallocation of resources among programme components on the basis of assessment of the situation, needs and performance of the components of a country programme, subject to the availability of resources;
 - Approval of revisions for change in the orientation of country programme components, as long as the increase in food value does not exceed USD 3 million; and
 - Approval of revisions designed to receive additional directed resources (above the regular development resources) to country programmes and development projects, keeping the Board regularly informed.

Budgetary Increases

- 3. Between 1 January and 31 December 2016, the Executive Director approved 41 budgetary increases within her delegated authority for development activities. The total food value of these increases amounted to USD 99 million and the total cost to WFP was USD 212 million. Detailed budget figures and reasons for each increase are given in the attached matrix.
- 4. Comparing these authorizations with those during 2015, the Executive Director approved the same number of budgetary increases during 2016, amounting to USD 50 million more in food transfer value and USD 101 million more in total cost to WFP.
- 5. The budgetary increases were undertaken for a number of reasons, including to accommodate: extensions in time; changes in beneficiary numbers; increase in capacity development and augmentation activities; the expansion of cash-based transfer modalities; or changes in operational costs due to increases in the associated costs.

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New Projects

6. Between 1 January and 31 December 2016, the Executive Director approved three new development projects, under her delegated authority. These new projects, in El Salvador and Zimbabwe, amount to USD 400,000 in food value and USD 9.8 million in total cost to WFP. Summaries of these operations are contained in separate documents.
