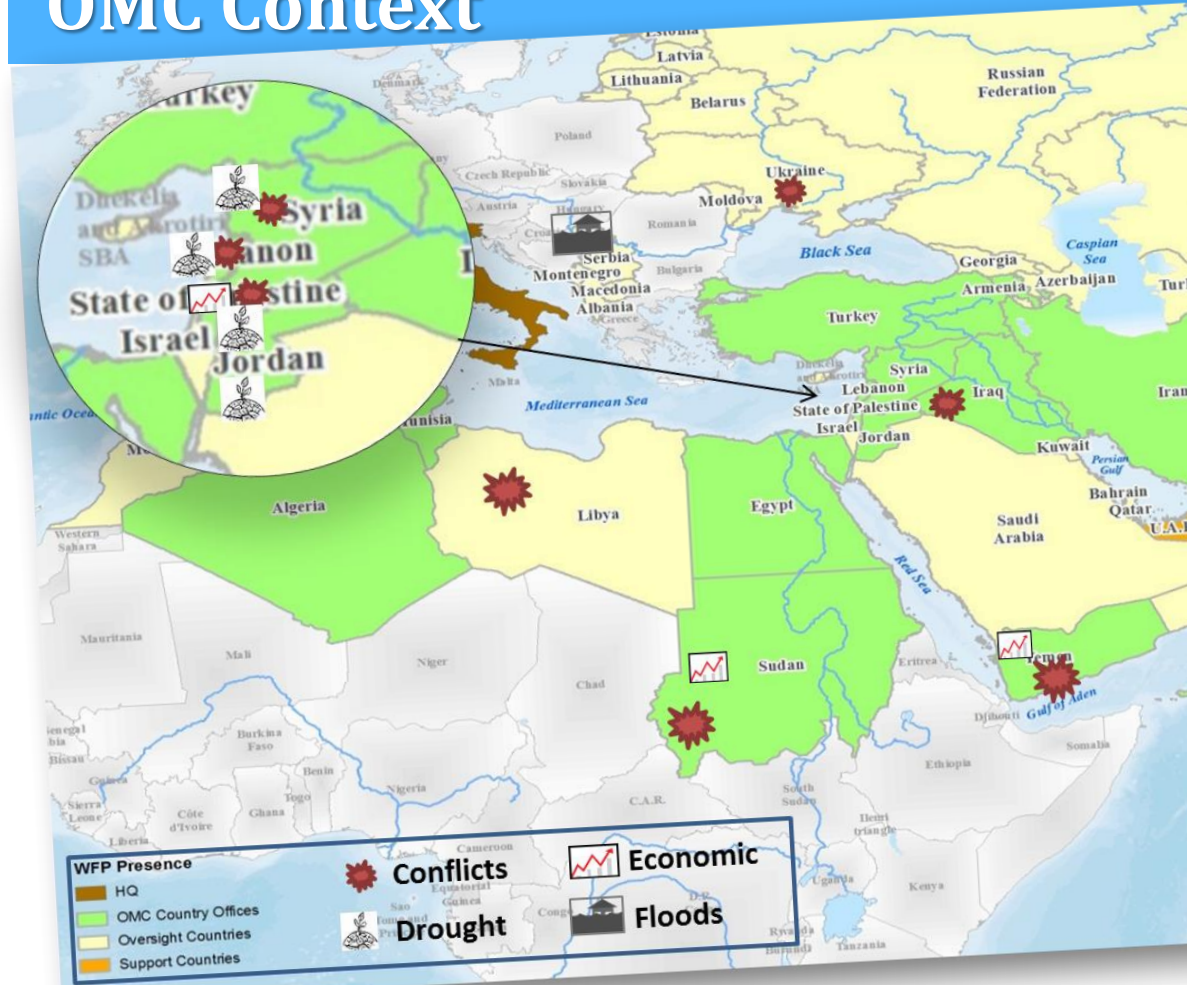

OMC Context



Armed Conflict: Iraq, Lebanon, Libya, Sudan, Syria (affecting Lebanon, Iraq, Jordan, Egypt and Turkey) Yemen and Ukraine

Protracted Refugee Caseloads: Algeria, Iran, Yemen, Palestine

Drought: Lebanon, Jordan, Syria, State of Palestine

Floods: Bosnia and Serbia

Emergency Response



Syria: Seeking to support 4.25 million people inside Syria each month

As a consequence of conflict-related access constraints and new regulations, number of people reached dropped from 4.1 million in March to 3.3 million in May

Sudan



Food Insecure population expected to reach 5 million people

Darfur Conflict and South Kordofan Crisis continues

Requirements increased to cater for refugees from South Sudan and new displacements in Darfur

Emergency Response



Despite security challenges, WFP remains engaged and has assisted with basic food and cash support to some 3 million most vulnerable people in June.

Yemen: Facing huge humanitarian challenges with 10 million food insecure people

Emergency Response



Iraq: Food assistance in Abu Ghraib areas affected by the floods caused by a hit dam

Anbar Crisis spreading beyond the borders of Anbar to the neighboring governorates

WFP providing support to IDPs and those affected by flood in Fallujah and Abu Ghraib

School Feeding activities are implemented in 10 countries, supporting 2.6 million beneficiaries

Innovations and Expansion of C&V

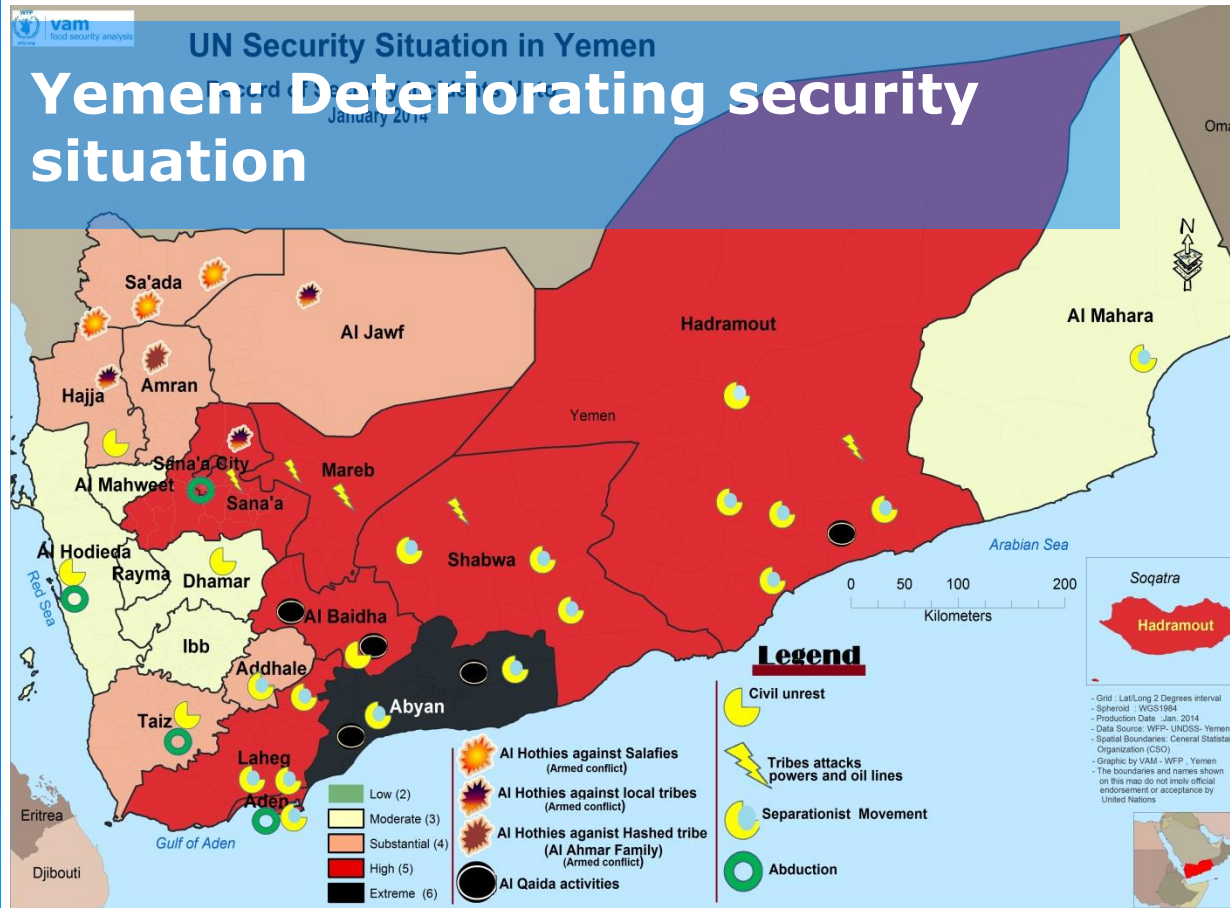


Palestine: WFP-UNRWA using electronic food vouchers to eventually reach 130,000 people

C&V transfers have grown significantly in the OMC region

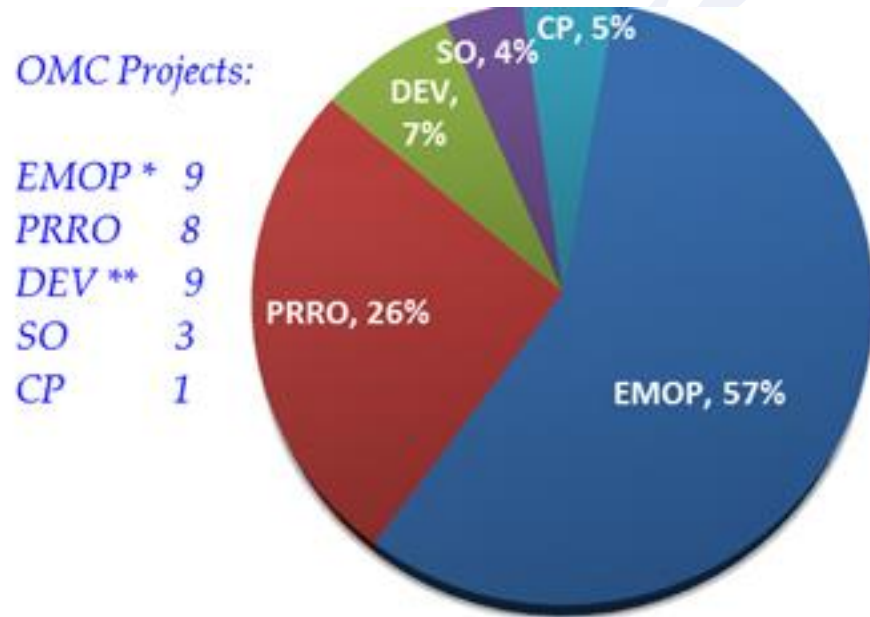
WFP Challenges and Risks

OMC Active Operations in 2014



OMC regional pipeline requirements for 2014: US\$ 1.5 billion, facing a shortfall of 65 percent.

Need to maintain a well-funded and balanced pipelines to ensure adequate and continued response to increasing humanitarian needs
