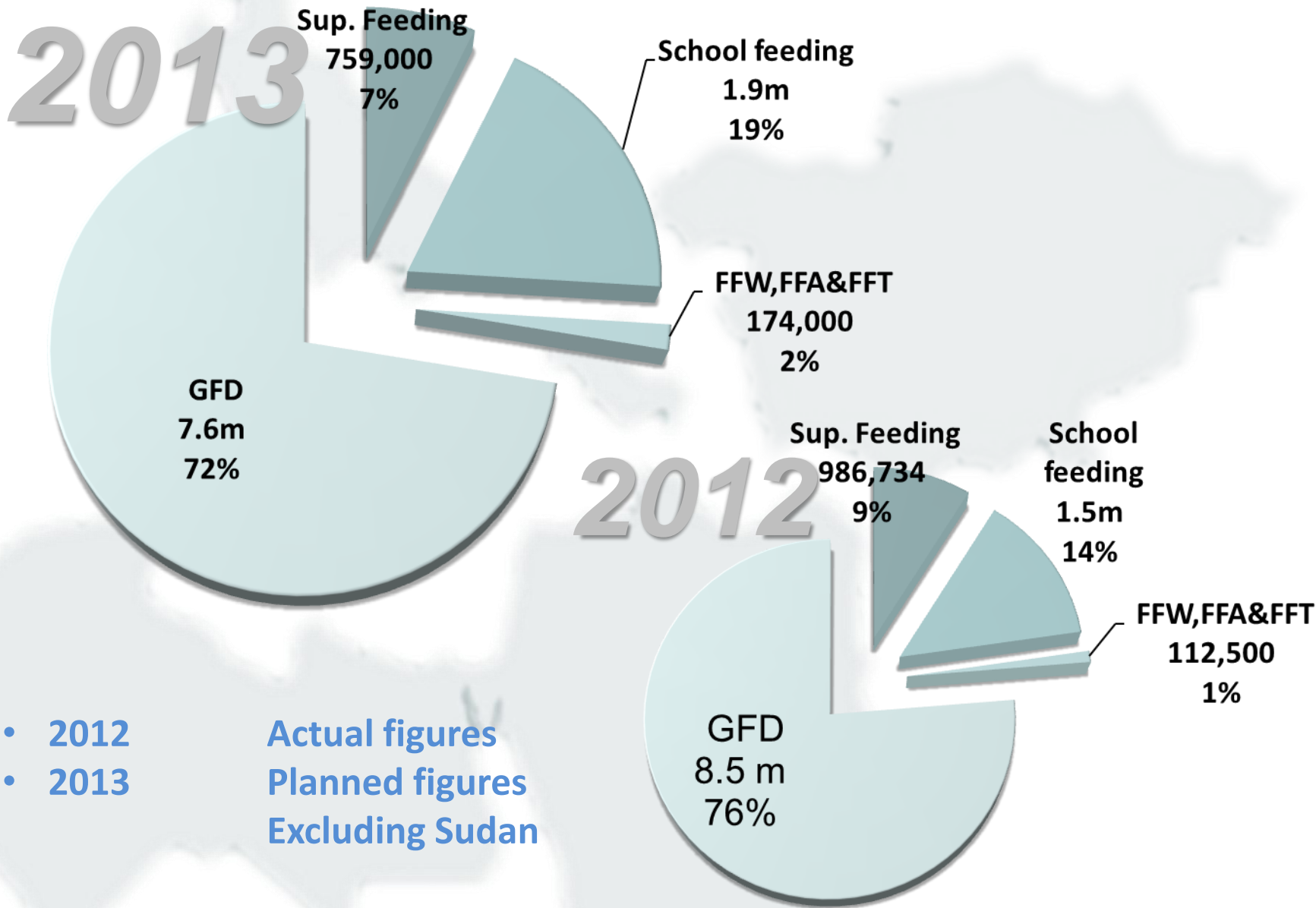


## OMC Portfolio



**The ODC portfolio includes 23 active operations in 15 countries; 13.5 million beneficiaries is valued at US\$ 1.5 billion required for 1 million mt of commodities and includes C&V activities implemented in 7 operations with a total value of US\$ 236.2 million. In addition to Sudan CO which will be providing support to 3.6 million beneficiaries**

## Emergency Preparedness and Response: - Responding to the **YEMEN** humanitarian needs

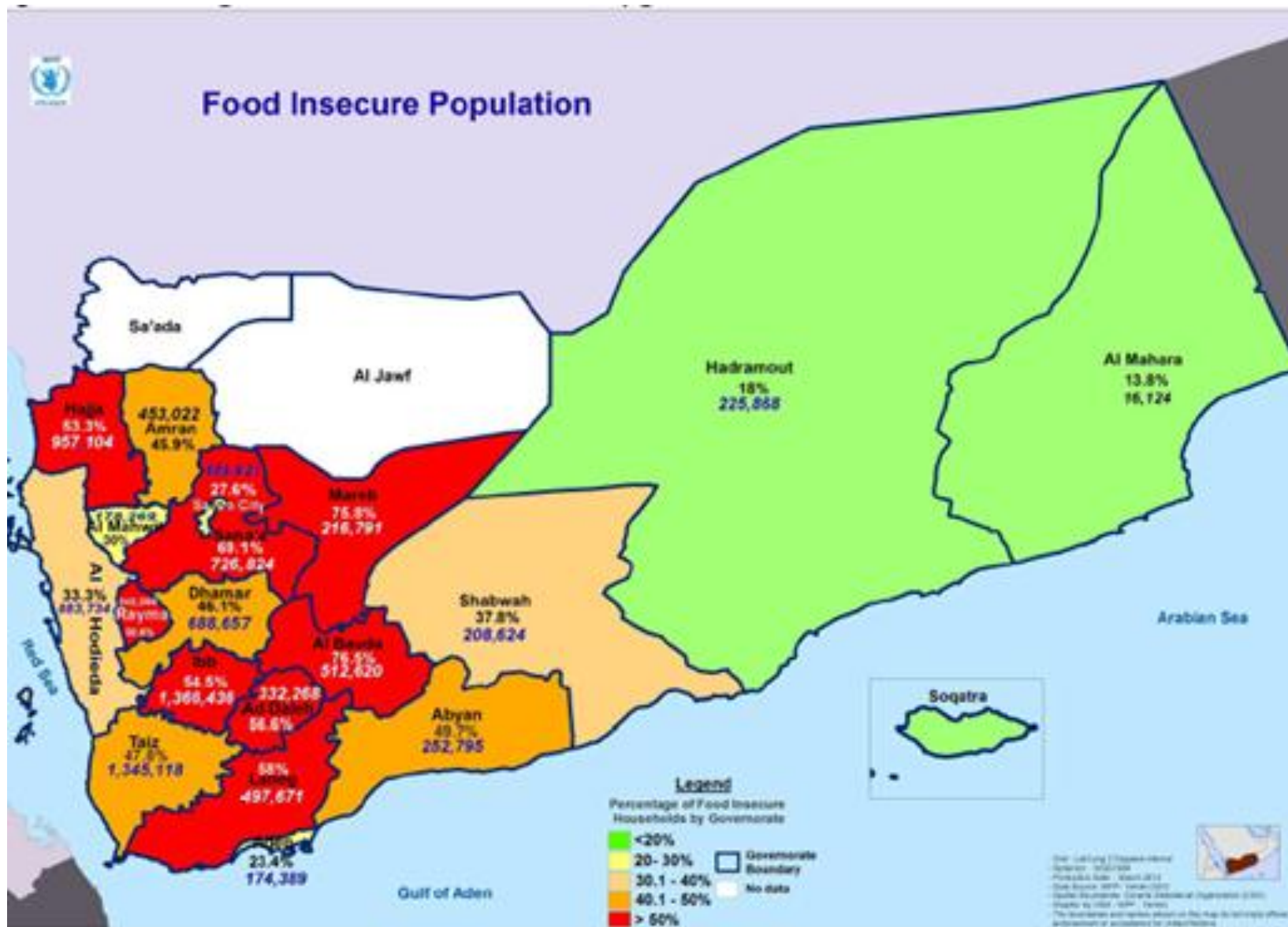


Almost half the population in Yemen (44.5 percent), 10 million persons, is food insecure  
Nearly 22 percent of the population, 5 million Yemenis, is suffering from severe food insecurity  
An additional 5 million people at risk  
Acute malnutrition rates (wasting) at 13%

## Emergency Preparedness and Response:

### - Responding to the **YEMEN** humanitarian needs



Targeting nearly five million people:

1. Food assistance under the emergency safety net activity to 3.5 million
2. Cash transfers for another 400,000;
3. Food assistance to 500,000 IDPs, war affected populations and returnees;
4. Nutrition support for 400,000 children under five and almost 160,000 women

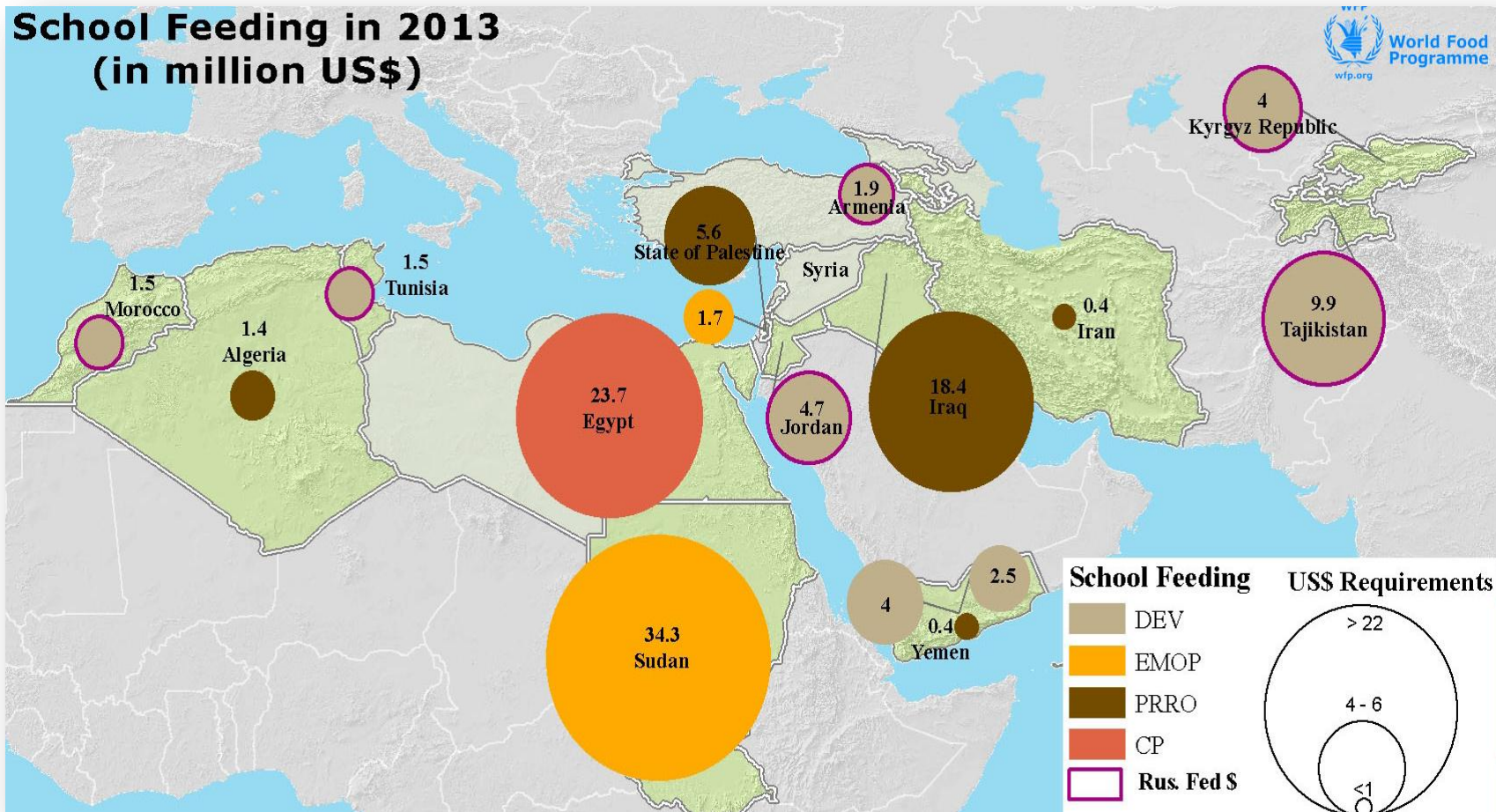
Providing support to 3.64 million beneficiaries in 2013 with a total budget: US\$359 million in SUDAN

Reaching 1.9 million beneficiaries through SF in 2013

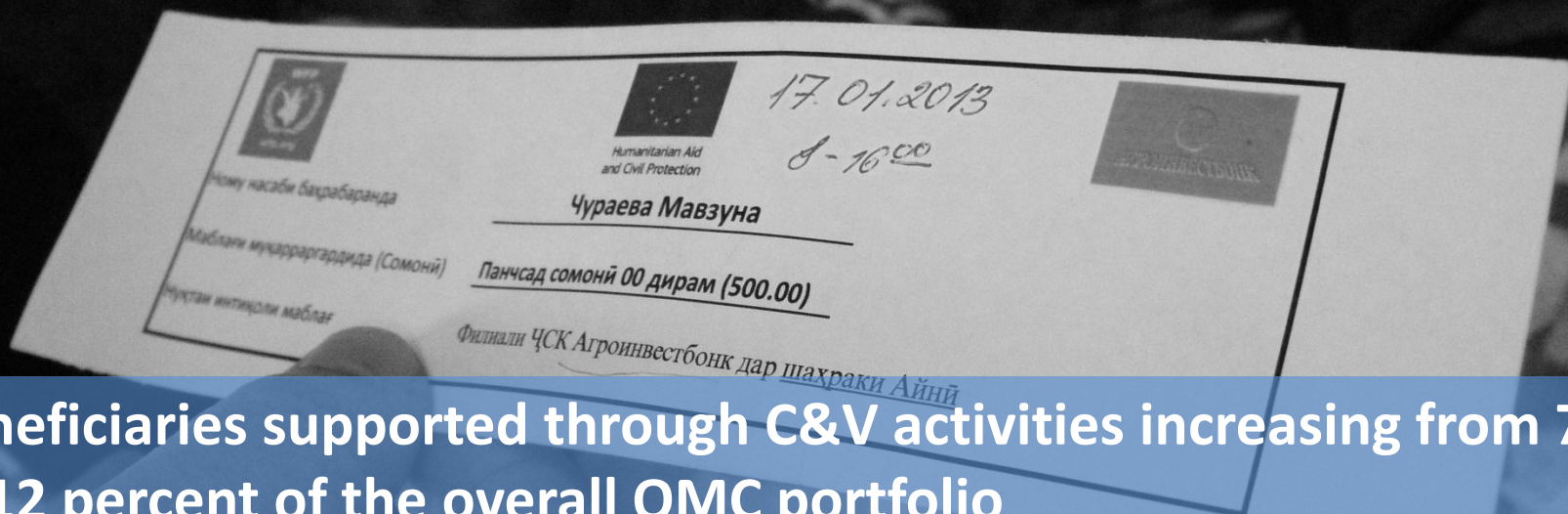

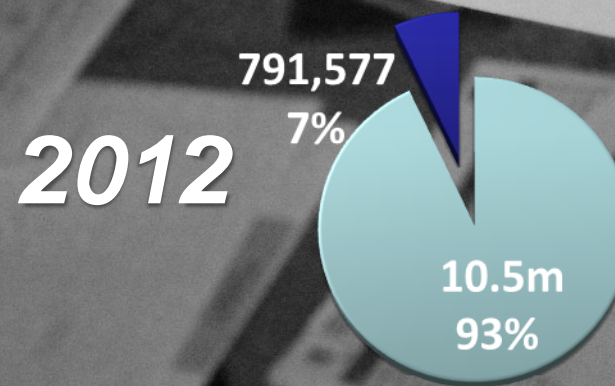
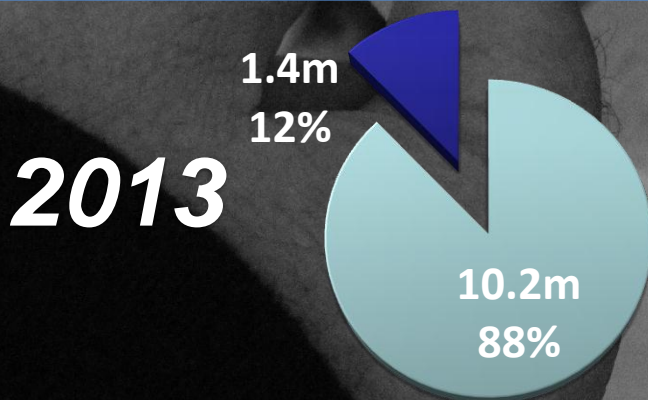




# Enhancing National Food Security - Cash and Voucher Programmes
