PREP LOGFRAME AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

GOAL: Capability to mount a more efficient and effective emergency response for up to 6 million beneficiaries (as per GRCM).

✓ Objective 1 (Capacities)

To strengthen WFP corporate response capacities to support emergency response for up to 6 million beneficiaries

Highlighted Accomplishments:

- Pre-positioned stocks of ready-to-use supplementary food for emergencies approved from the Forward Purchasing Facility (FPF).
- Comprehensive inter-divisional review of WFP's non-food item Corporate Response Stocks (CRS) nearing completion.
- WFP's corporate system 'StaffNet' revamped to accommodate corporate response roster.
- Basic emergency training course 'Getting Ready for Emergencies' revised for production in February 2013.

PREP LOGFRAME

✓ Objective 2 (Abilities)

To strengthen the accountability and coherence of WFP's response management

Highlighted Accomplishments:

- Suite of Organizational Resilience Circulars/tools developed and issued.
- EPRP Package is now a corporate requirement and implemented in 70% of WFP Country Offices.
- Lessons Learned tool-kit piloted, as a support tool for regional/country offices; exercises nearing completion in the Horn of Africa and the Sahel.

PREP LOGFRAME

✓ Objective 3 (External)

To strengthen partnership with national authorities, the international humanitarian community and other humanitarian actors for a more effective humanitarian response

Highlighted Accomplishments:

- Initial set of CAPRO training package developed for NDMAs.
- Global mapping exercise of NDMAs conducted in two regions and initiated in the rest.
- Draft guidelines on CD responsibilities for cluster implementation at the country level.
- Inputs to the design of an inter-agency rapid response mechanism (IARRM).
- Strengthened regional Civil-Military Coordination presence Focal Points in three Regional Bureaux.

POST-PREP EPR STRENGTHENING

Sustainable Funding Issues:

- Emergency Training
- UN Humanitarian Response Depot (UNHRD)
- Logistics Services (Rotary Wing, Truck Fleet)
- Cluster Activities

Corporate EPR Strengthening:

- Strategy developed for linking EPR KM/Lessons Learned to EPRS requirements and priorities
- Link EPRS with internal funding allocation decisions
- Developing more predictable EPR funding mechanisms.
