Operational Objectives

Addressing tuberculosis and food insecurity – a new development approach for WFP Tajikistan

- Help achieve higher treatment success and cure rates.
- Provide a safety net to patients' families during the treatment.

Duration	3 years
Number of beneficiaries	136,000 (45,000 patients)
Food tonnage	12,483 mt
Total cost to WFP	US\$ 7 million
