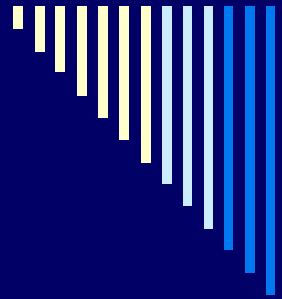

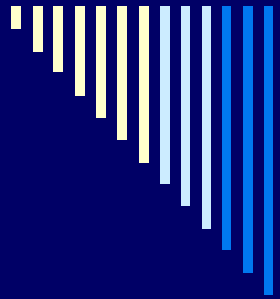
- 1 April 2008 – 31 March 2010

- USD 288 million total cost





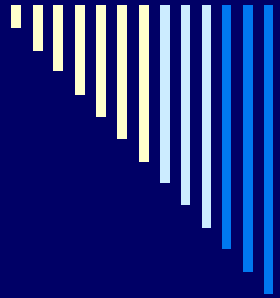
persistent vulnerability to hunger

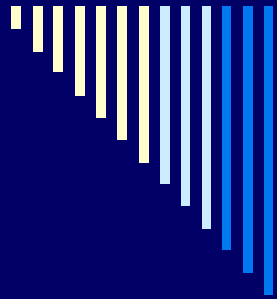
objectives

- increased confidence



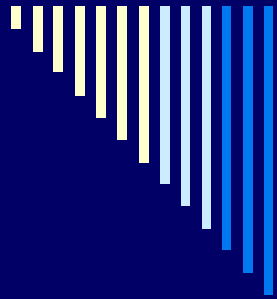
Community Mapping Process



Completed Community Map



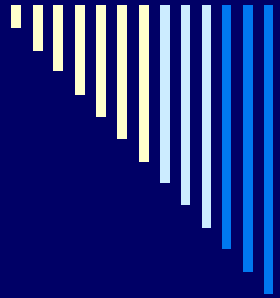
