

**Emergency Preparedness** 

An Emergency Operation (EMOP) meets the relief food needs of people displaced or affected by conflict, or of victims of natural disasters or other crises

In 2005 and 2006 WFP operational expenditures on EMOPs exceeded US\$ 1 billion. In 2007was around US\$ 850 million






- Daily monitoring of over 160 information sources
- Covers natural hazards, socio-political events
- Predictive, not reactive
- Integrated with Regional Bureaux
- Aimed at triggering preparedness actions










WFP needs to have the capacity to respond to 4 corporate emergencies occurring in the same year
