WFP, FAO and IFAD, all based in Rome, often combine their expertise in agriculture, food aid and rural development.



Within the UN family, the mandates of the three Rome-based agencies - WFP, the Food and Agriculture Organisation (FAO) and the International Fund for

Agricultural Development (IFAD) - complement one another.

Each is working to fulfill the World Food Summit's aim of eradicating global hunger and poverty: WFP with food aid, FAO through its technical expertise in agriculture and IFAD via international financial assistance.
