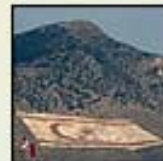

Every year, WFP operations reach an average of more than 90 million people in over 80 countries. At any given moment, many of the agency's key projects run the risk of a break in food supplies due to lack of funding. This can have a devastating impact on beneficiaries who often rely entirely on assistance from WFP to survive.

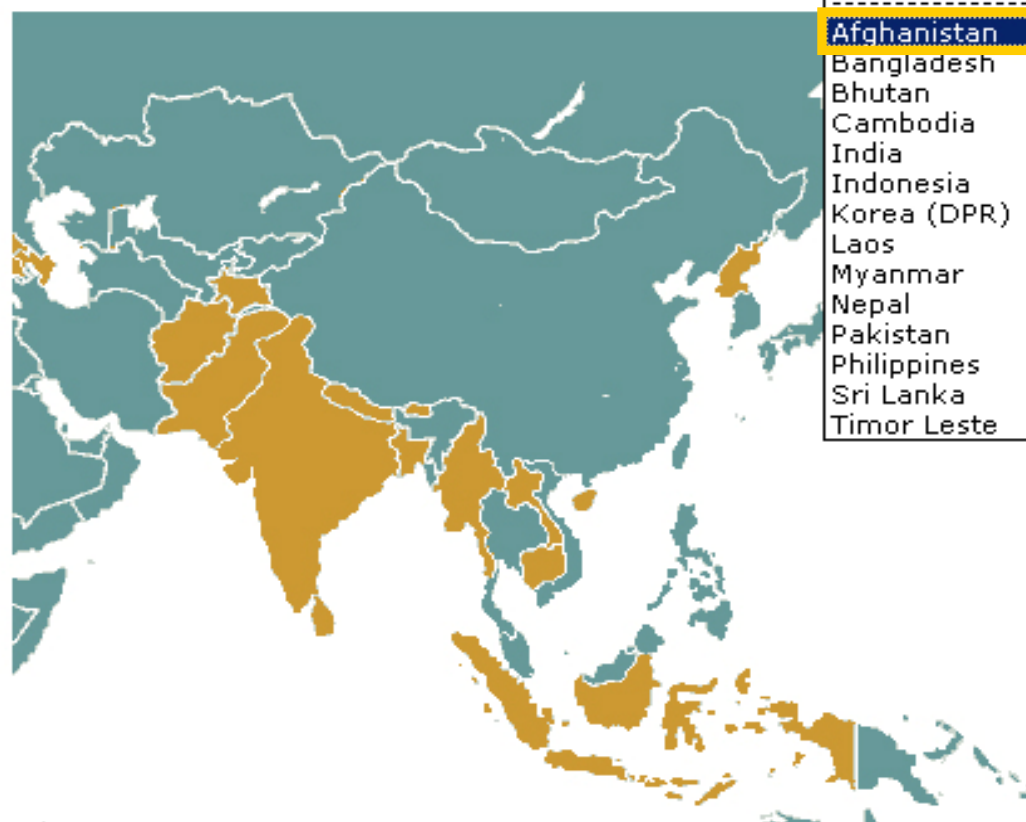

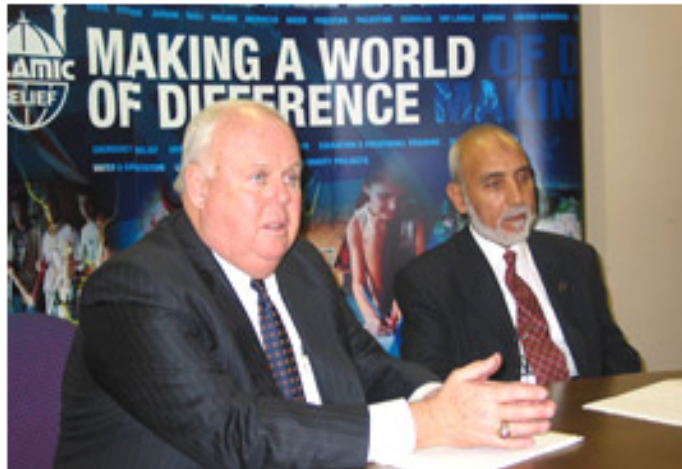
