



WFP Work Plan (2013-2016)




✓ 58 quality credible and useful evaluations of single WFP operations that mirror the organization's Plan of Work

# Features of the 2016 Synthesis







## Overall Assessment – Year 4 Synthesis



Relevance & Appropriateness: Overall appropriate, at design and over time

**Effectiveness:** Mixed but improved

**Output:** broadly effective

Outcome: improving availability of data but quality and reliability concerns persist

**Efficiency:** Mixed – at times limited by conditionality of contributions

**Gender:** Mixed but improved at design/analysis

**Protection**: Targets mostly met

Accountability to Affected Populations: Half of the evaluations recorded targets met


**Enabling Environment:** Mixed namely in terms of transition planning
