# Syria Crisis Response Update



## 2017 Achievements (Syria)

- Over **4.2 million** people received WFP assistance in all **14** governorates. This includes more than **1.4 million** people in hard-to-reach and besieged areas.
- WFP assisted diverse population groups in need - internally displaced, young children, school children, and pregnant and nursing women through a portfolio of adapted interventions, such as General Food Assistance, nutrition and education support activities.

# Syria Crisis Response Update



## 2017 Achievements (Regional Operation)

- **2.5 million** people received WFP assistance in Turkey, Jordan, Lebanon, Egypt, and Iraq
- **Adaptation, Innovation, and Scale-up:**  
Emergency Social Safety Net (ESSN), iris scan, OneCard platforms, blockchain, transition to 'Choice'
- **USD 540 million** injected into the regional economy (USD 3 billion since 2012)

## Operational Update


- **Syrian government ban** on procurement of all commodities from Turkey
  
- **Targeting and Vulnerability Assessments**
  - Continuing exercise in partnership with other actors
  - Funding constraints and impact on targeting
  
- **Gradual expansion of sustainable livelihoods activities**
  - Joint programming and complementary partnerships with UN agencies

Requirements vs. Confirmed Contributions (in million USD)


