508,000 refugees from DR Congo in neighbouring countries




389,000 people reached by WFP in December (Kasai)

Operational Challenges



RESTRICTED HUMANITARIAN ACCESS

Widespread violence and insecurity, ongoing armed conflict, risk of violence against humanitarian personnel



INADEQUATE PHYSICAL AND SOCIAL INFRASTRUCTURE

Impassable roads, collapsed bridges, low market capacity



SUPPLY CHAIN ISSUES

6-8 week lead time, no local procurement options for nutrition commodities



FUEL SHORTAGES

ongoing shortage of fuel in Kasai



FUNDING

Significant shortfalls, funding urgently needed due to long lead times
