The rotating seat was occupied by a country of: List A- First term- 2000/2001/2002, List B- Second Term- 2003/2004/2005, List A- Third Term- 2006/2007/2008, and List C- Fourth Term- 2009/2010/2011.
- (2) Switzerland was elected for the term 2009/2010/2011. However following an agreement, Switzerland resigned in favour of Ireland effective 1 January 2011. Ireland will occupy the seat for the remainder of the term
- (3) Luxembourg was elected for the term 2010/2011/2012. However following an agreement, Luxembourg resigned in favour of Spain effective 1 January 2011. Spain will occupy the seat for the remainder of the term

The UN General Assembly and the FAO Conference (in resolution 53/223 of 23 April 1999 and 6/99 of 13 November 1999 respectively) approved the distribution of seats at the WFP Executive Board with effect from 1 January 2000 and requested that it be reviewed two years before the end of one full rotation scheme of four terms. Such review is being undertaken; the results shall enter into force on 1 January 2012.
