
"On a pure cost comparison, soil and water conservation practices could save between \$844m and \$4,490m over 20 years as compared with late response."

National Sub-National **Integrated Context Analysis** Identifies priority geographic areas




Seasonal Livelihood Planning

Multi-year, multi-sector community driven action plan




### **Convergence in Action**
