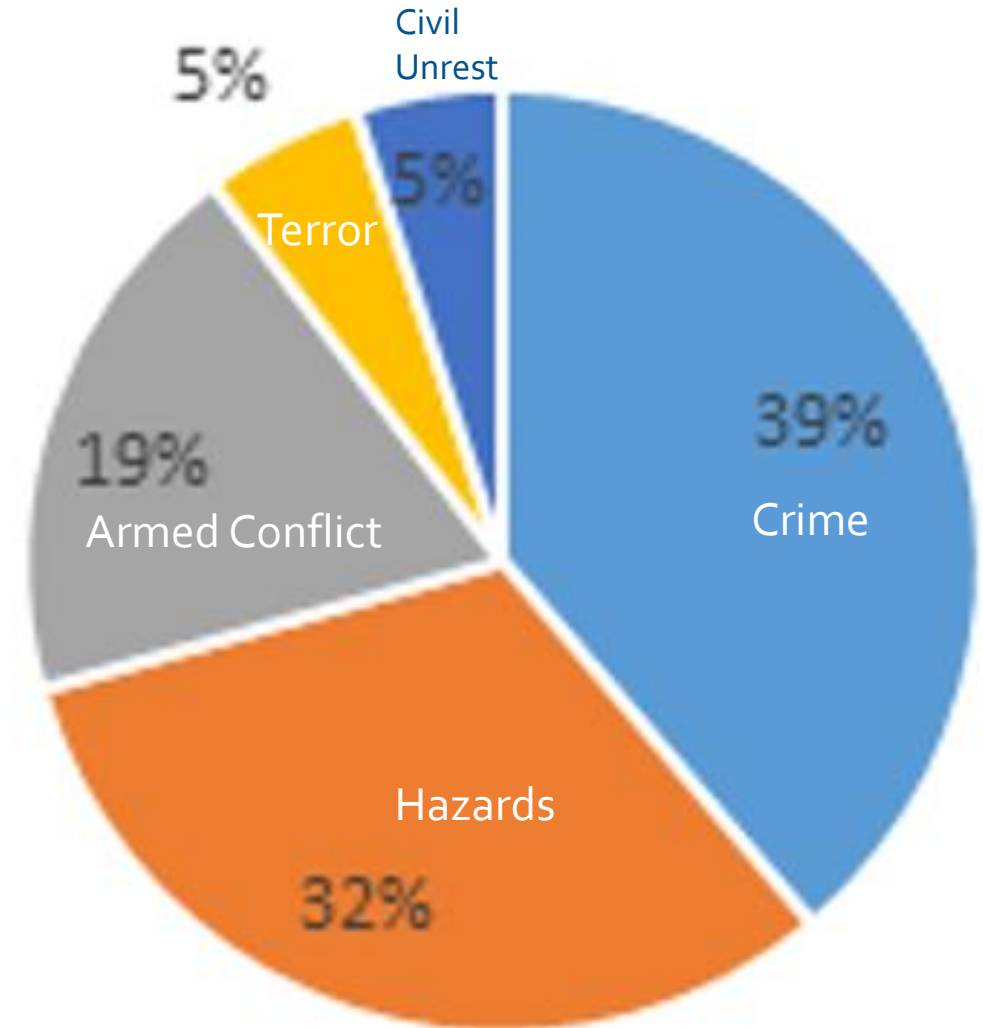

6 MONTH OVERVIEW



- 242 recorded security incidents since last briefing
- Four people died working on behalf of WFP (Yemen / DRC / South Sudan)
- Nine people sustained major injuries
- Comparison to first half 2017:
 - Slight drop in incident numbers
 - Armed Conflict Increased, Crime Decreased
- 2017 trend continues: partners more targeted than ourselves >> exploring joint training/awareness



SOUTH SUDAN: OFFICE ATTACKED



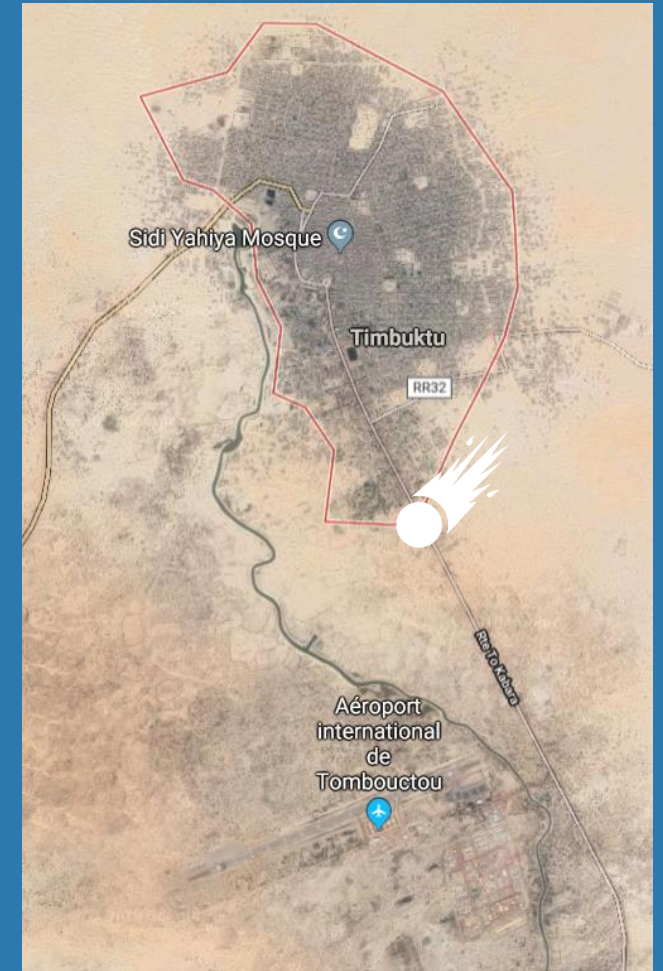

Timbuktu, Airport Road

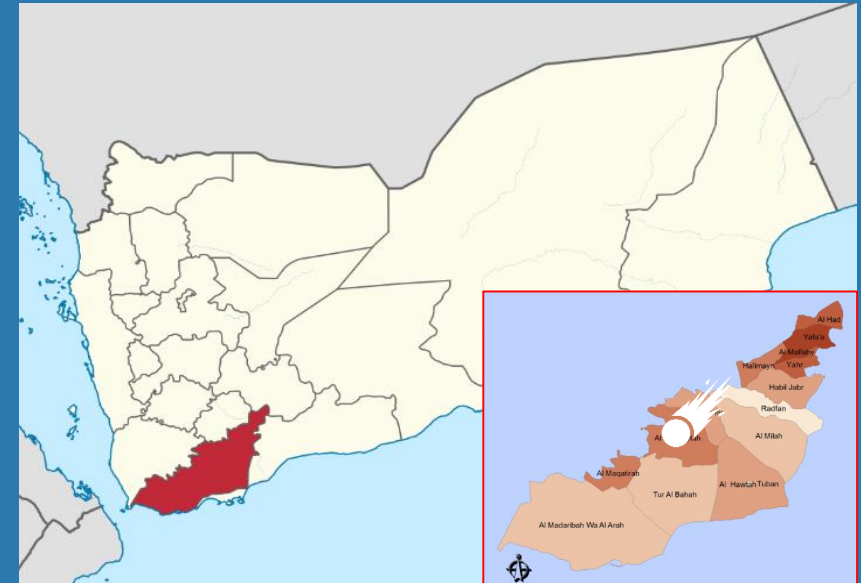


YEMEN: TRUCK HIT

YEMEN: SHIP ATTACKED

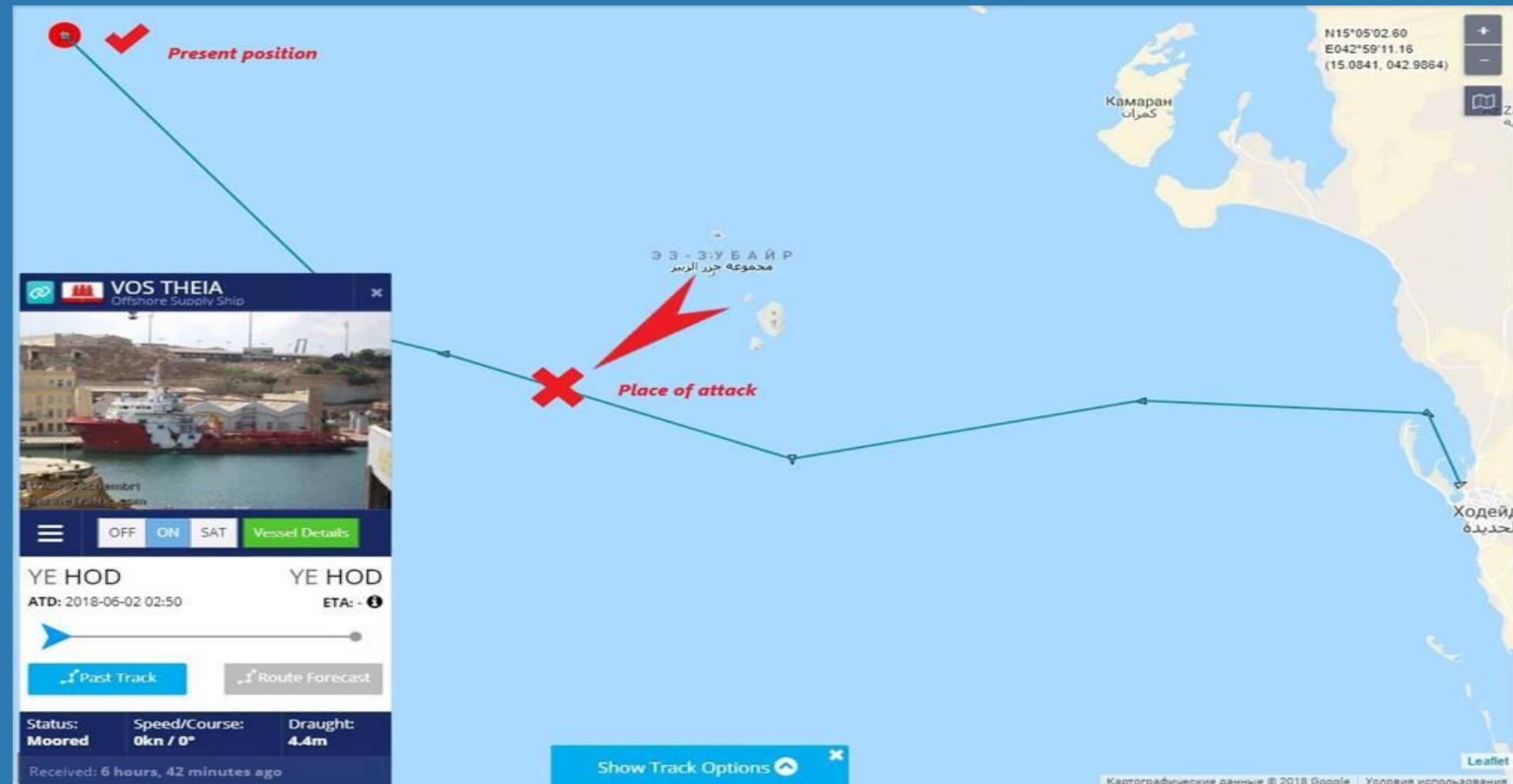


Direct attack on VOS Theia, a WFP chartered ship, 03 June, 17.30Hrs

VOS Theia fully operational

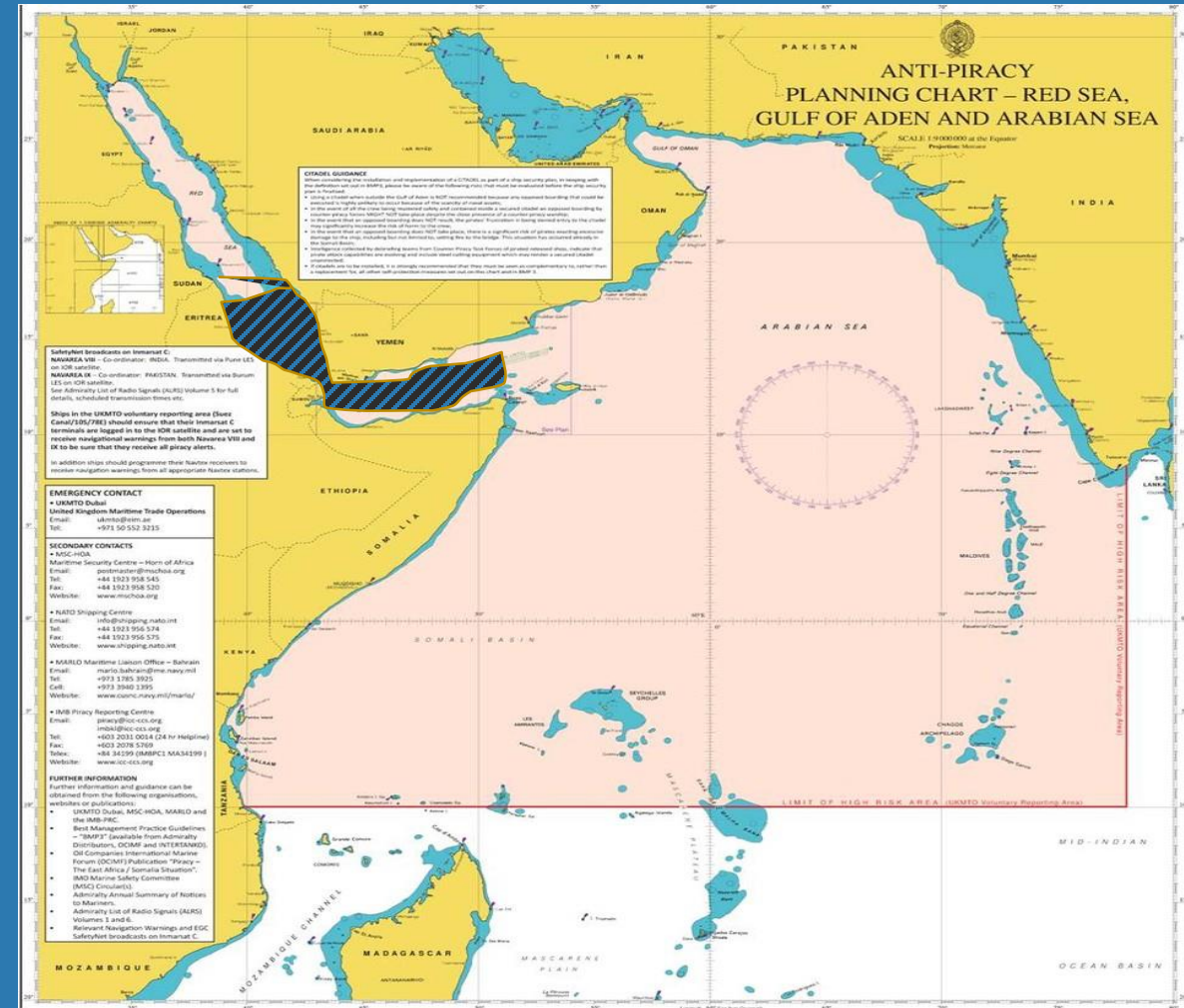


NOTE ON MARITIME SECURITY



Issues:

- WFP Shipping is tracked and protected by EUNAVFOR Op Atalanta – but limited to Somalia shipping and protection against piracy
- Better solutions needed for areas around Yemen
- PAST onboard vessels re-emphasized
- Industry effort
