Management KPIs

Initial proposal → include only the three high level CRF Category I KPIs

Revised proposal → INCLUDE also components (24) for Category I KPIs and

→ ADD selected Category II KPIs in relevant topics

- Category I KPIs: in the approved r-CRF, and MP 2019-2021 (with targets)
 - keeping same information as before & expand on previous indicators adding visuals => towards higher level strategic decision-making
- Category II KPIs: in the MP 2019-2021 (with targets)
 - Annually confirmed by WFP senior management, BUT selected ones will remain.
