Update on CCA and UNSDCF engagement

Latest developments

- Development Coordination Office (DCO) finalizing streamlined interim technical guidance known as “Companion Pieces”. New online version to be issued in July 2020.
- UNCTs worldwide are updating their Common Country Analysis (CCA) to accelerate UNSDCF adoption – focusing first on socio-economic analysis to gauge impact of COVID-19.
- The UN system will remain in transition mode throughout 2020 while adjusting to unprecedented crises (“development emergency”), using the UN SG’s Framework (UN socio-economic response to COVID-19).

WFP measures

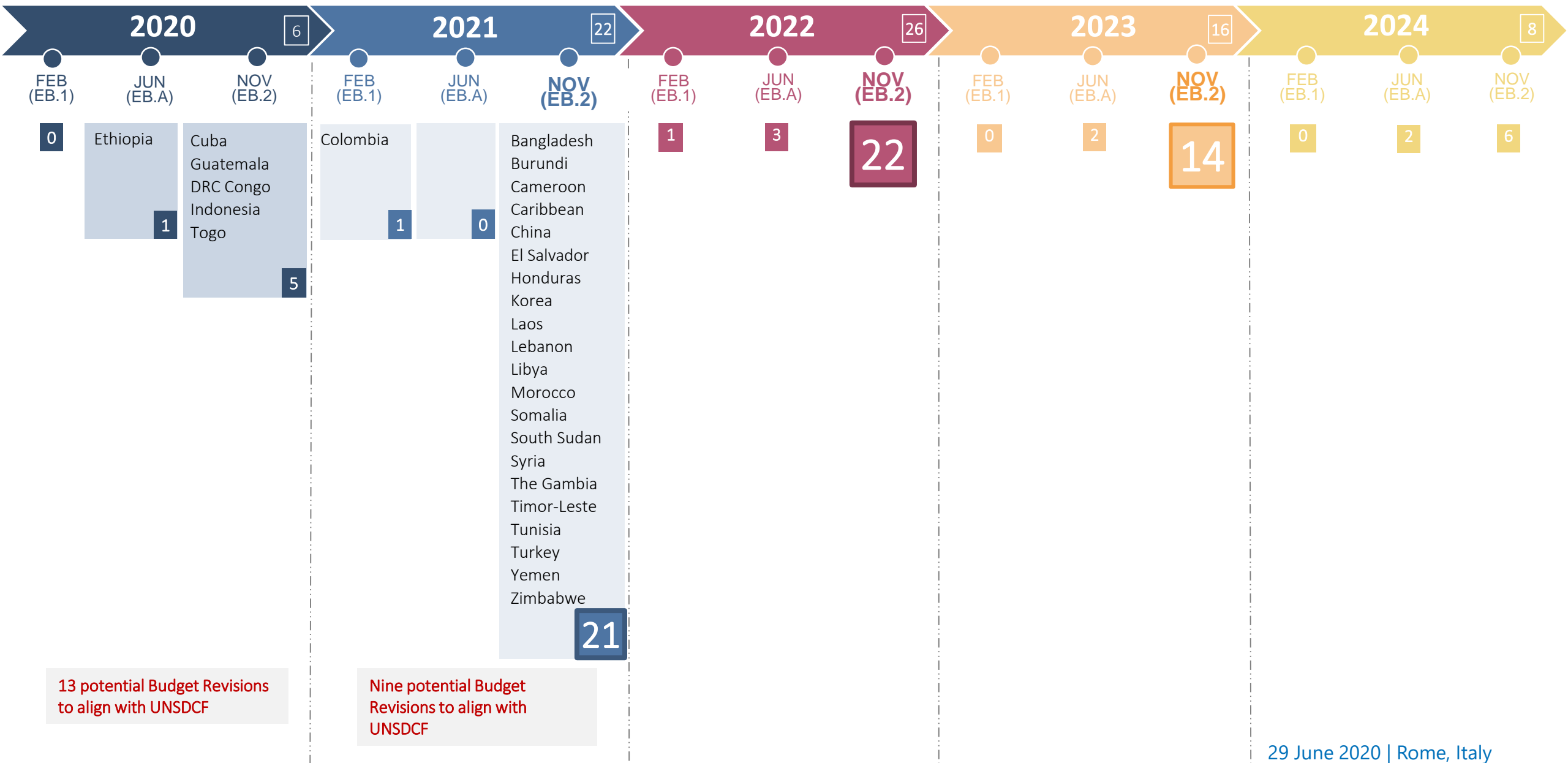
- Updated preliminary internal guidance.
- Developed a Medium Term Programme Framework, for responding to the “development emergency”.
- Continue to engage in discussions on the Humanitarian-Development-Peace Nexus and Collective Outcomes.
- Advancing collaboration with sister agencies around joint assessments and joint programming.
- Strengthened internal coordination mechanisms for CSP development, both horizontally (between HQ divisions) and vertically (between HQ and the field).

Sequencing of CSPs vis-a-vis UNSDCF

- Adequate sequencing of various processes is complex.
- Reached agreement with DCO and sister agencies on the following arrangements:
 1. Default scenario is to approve CSPs before the UNSDCF to fully align cycles from day one.
 2. In case UNSDCFs are delayed, agencies have the option to submit their documents for Executive Board approval ahead of the UNSDCF - as long as there is general agreement on the UNCT's general strategic positioning and draft UNSDCF outcomes are available.
 3. Recognizing the challenges in syncing the different processes, agencies have up to one year to align their documents with the UNSDCF after its start date.
