- **USD 35M** sourced from the World Bank for multi-sector Rohingya/COVID-19 crisis response.

Government of Chad

- **USD 22M** sourced from the World Bank to support the COVID-19 National Response Plan for Food Security, to reach almost 500,000 people.

Government of Haiti

USD 40.7M sourced from the Inter American Development Bank and World Bank for a safety net for those affected by COVID-19.

Government of Liberia

- **USD 30M** sourced from the World Bank and IMF for household food support due to COVID-19.

Government of Mali

- **USD 12.5M** sourced from the World Bank to respond to the lean season with the provision of food value vouchers.

Government of Mozambique

- **USD 3.8M** sourced from the World Bank to provide cash transfers to Cyclone Idai and Kenneth-affected populations.

Government of Nicaragua

- **USD 20M** sourced from the IMF to address urgent balance of payments resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic.
