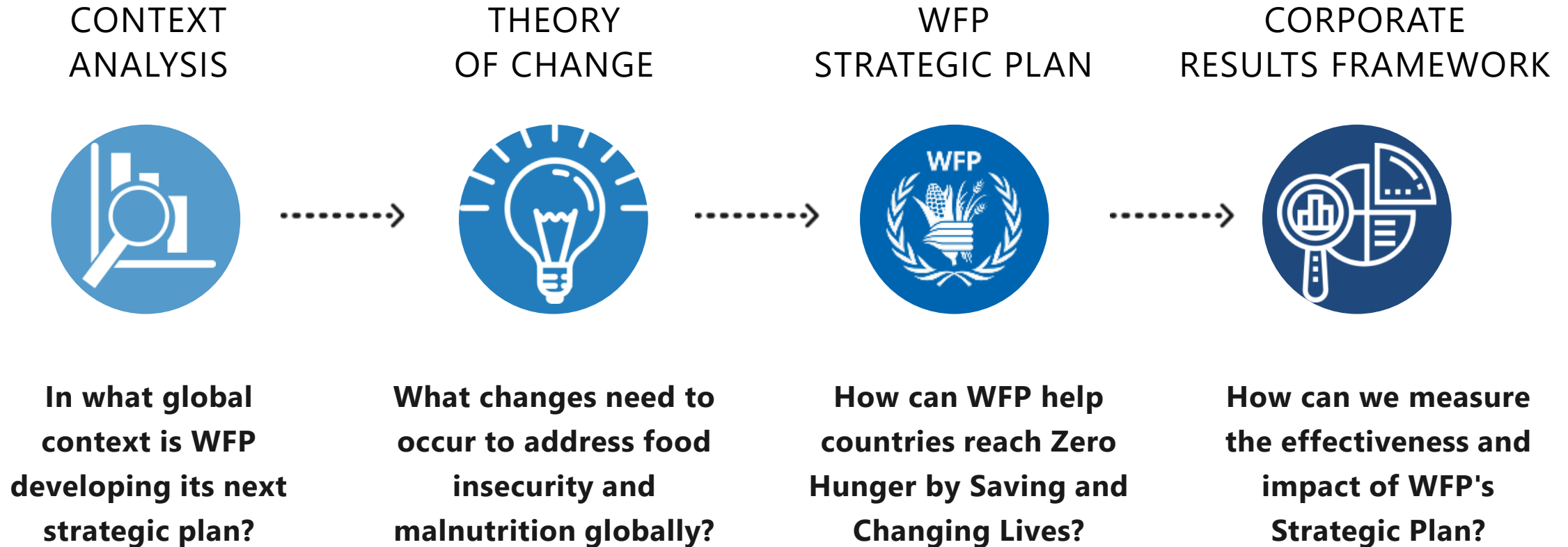

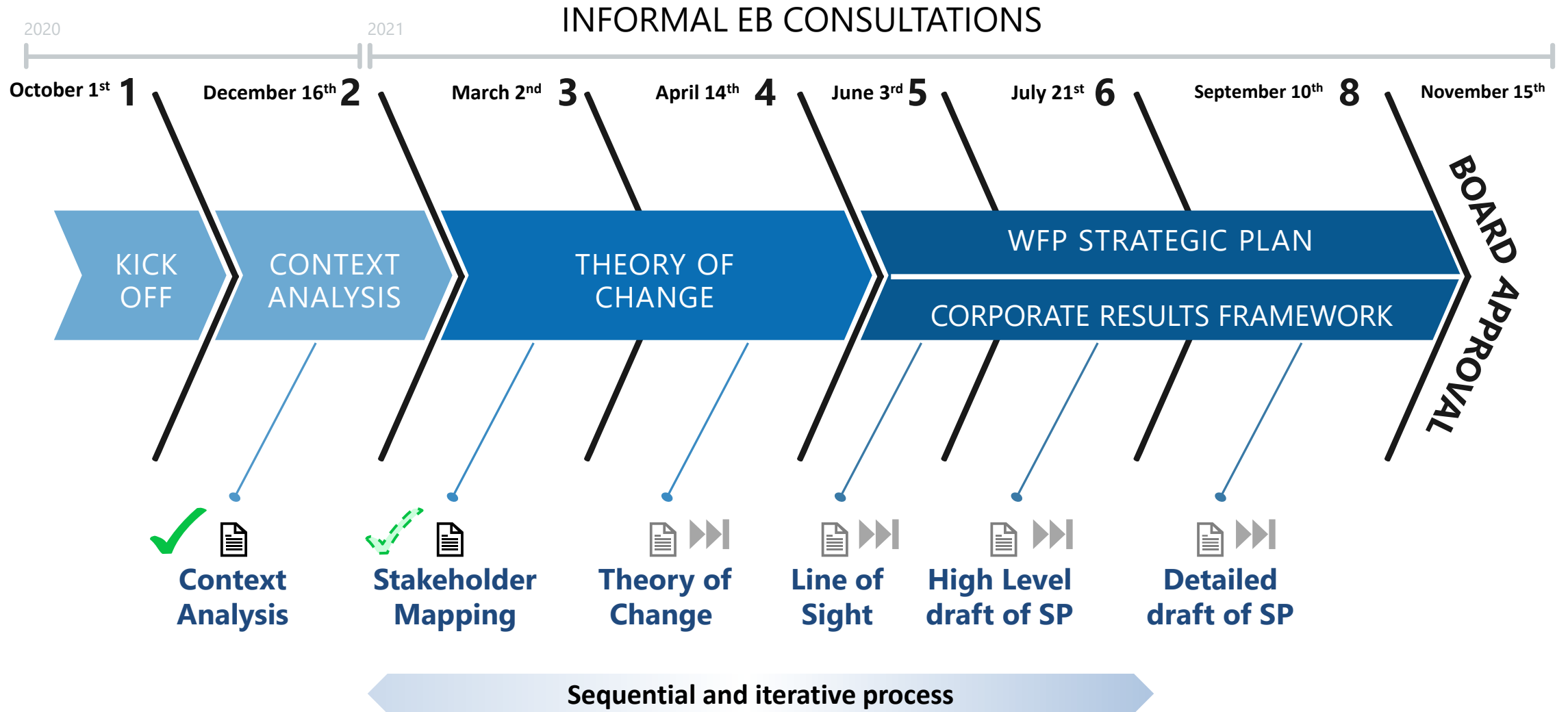

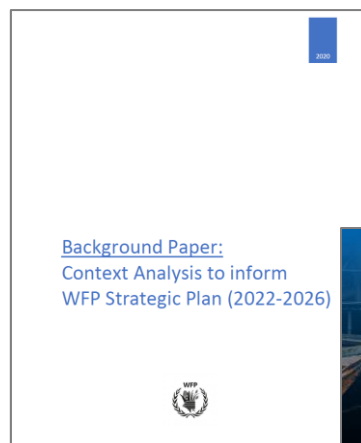

- **More extensive analysis on funding landscape**, including innovative financing

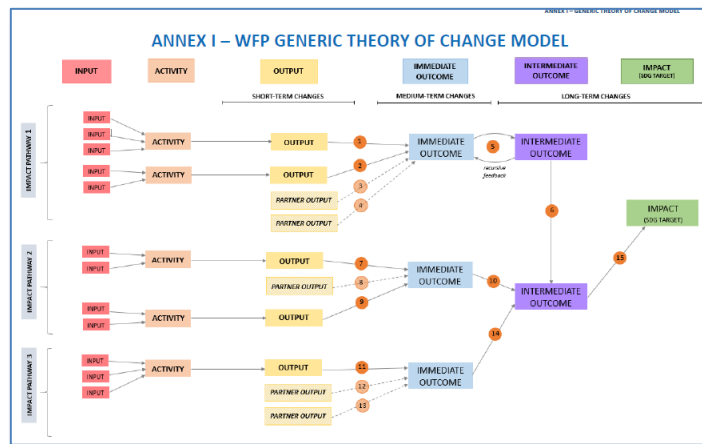
WFP Strategic Plan: Root Cause Analysis and Theory of Change

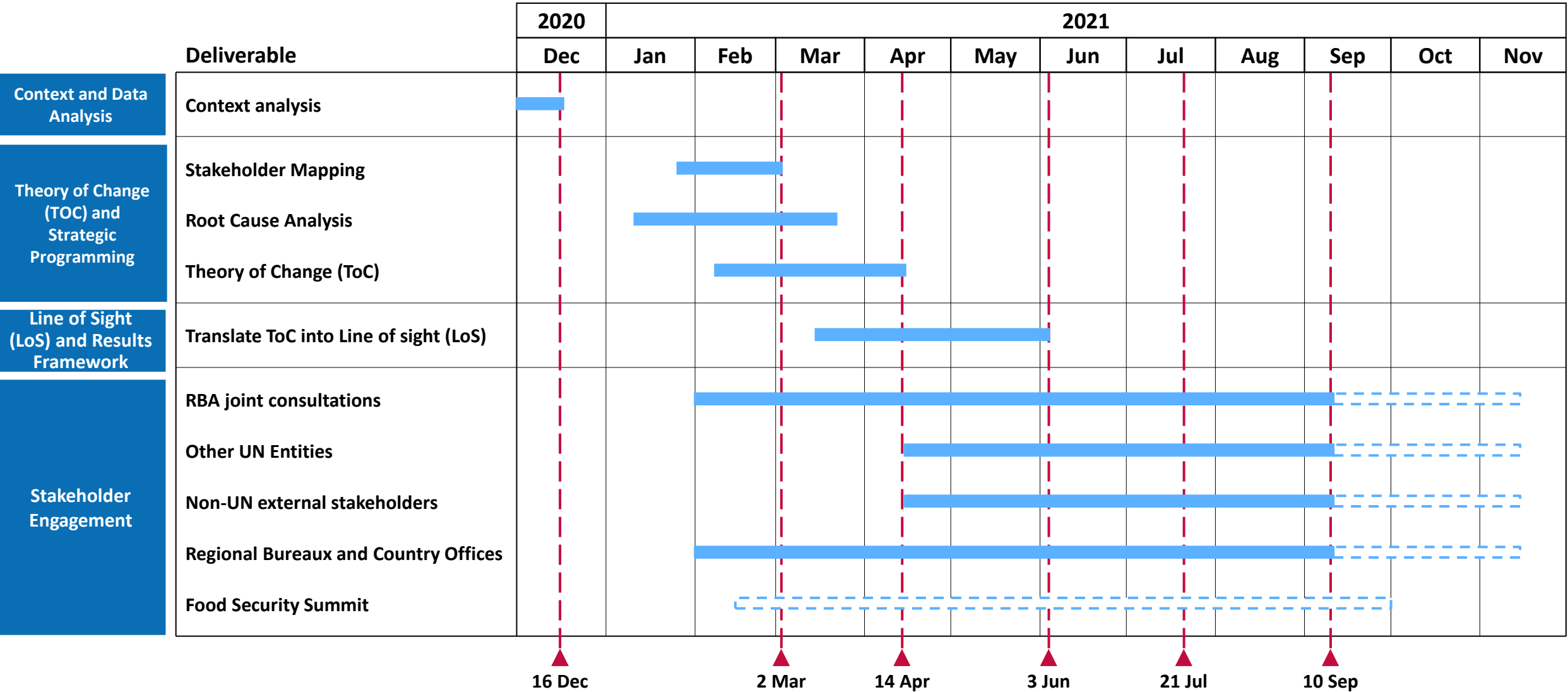
